

The Chair declared the motion carried.

The resolution as adopted reads as follows:

RESOLUTION CREATING THE ANN ARBOR ENERGY COMMISSION

The City Council resolves that there is hereby created an Energy Commission which shall operate as follows:

- (1) The Commission shall have 11 members who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council;
- (2) Commission members shall serve for three-year terms. However, the Mayor shall designate seven of the initial appointees for two- or one-year terms so that no more than four terms shall expire in any one year;
- (3) The Commission shall adopt its own bylaws and appoint its own officers;
- (4) The Commission shall:
  - (a) Address City policies regarding energy efficiency;
  - (b) Make periodic public reports and recommendations on means of improving municipal and community energy efficiency;
  - (c) Prepare, adopt, amend and transmit to City Council plans identifying municipal energy production and energy efficiency projects; and
  - (d) Prepare, adopt, amend and transmit to City Council plans on community-based energy production and energy efficiency projects;
- (5) The Commission shall keep its meetings and records open in accordance with the standards of the Freedom of Information Act and Open Meeting Act;
- (6) Commission members may be removed by the Council with or without cause; and

RESOLVED, that the Mayor's Energy Advisory Board be dissolved upon appointment of the representatives to the Energy Commission.
