Updated draft of ordinance was not ready to review as intended, so this meeting will be a check-in.

Update on Spin's experiments to determine how they can best deploy in the community and anticipate they will be asking for feedback to identify gaps where they might help.

Luke (Traffic Engineer) is monitoring traffic; Monday (3/9) vs. Monday (3/16) car measurable traffic was down 50%.

AAATA has seen 75% drop in ridership and trying to figure out the balance of providing service and operational costs; worried about driver help.

Suggestion to look at hospital area & commuter as option for Spin to help people get into and out of the hospital campus.

Ford School students are working with Detroit to figure out how to best deploy scooters; will reach out to Detroit to learn their strategies.

HEH/UrbanRider are loaning cargo bikes to local businesses to make deliveries.

The subcommittee will review the cleaned up ordinance draft over email and send in suggestions and it will go to legal for review.

City had planned to work with Transportation for America curb space management project; looks like it will be put on hold. Curbside parking for short term pickup and parking for micromobility is part of that discussion. Also mentioned interest in improving parking options for people with disabilities & parallel discussions on those issues.
