Gladstone–SF outdoor areas include the guarded beach, the foyer of the beach house, the skate park, all of the neighborhood playgrounds, and designated non-motorized trails. Effective 9/4/12.  
Village of Elsie–posted signs, no formal written policy  
Harbor Springs City docks, Zorn Park, and the City beach are SF  
Delta Township Parks (all parks and trails). 9/5/13  
City of Hastings Parks (including e-cigarettes–all parks and city owned/operated facilities). Effective 9/23/13  
Ottawa County, all beaches

## **Smoke-Free Designated Areas**

Ingham County Park System (playgrounds and beaches)

Marine City—local beach and playground—ordinance 9/1/12—include up to a \$75 fine

Eaton County parks passed a designated smoking areas park policy

City of Eaton Rapids—smoke-free areas policy—designated smoking areas

City of Traverse City (playgrounds and waterfront)

Garfield Township (Grand Traverse County)

Sands Township in Marquette County—Smoke-free pavilion and playground with 2 signs—July 2013

St. Clair County Parks—playgrounds and splash pad designated non-smoking—not a policy or ordinance, but designated by commissioners and will include signage

City of Fremont—ordinance and resolution banning smoking in specific areas of several parks in Fremont

City of Muskegon—One area at Pere Marquette Beach is TF – area between the restroom buildings and the pier.

City of Charlotte—No person shall smoke any tobacco product within 50 feet of any playground.

## **Other (Parks governed privately)**

NW Fraternal Little League—on City of Midland property (SF policy adopted by NW Fraternal Little League Baseball officers)

Petoskey Youth Soccer Association—Click Road Soccer Complex, effective 3/2013—Tobacco-free

Jacob's Corn Maze, Traverse City (Grand Traverse County)

Discovery Center—Tall Ship Manitou, Maritime Heritage Alliance, The Watershed Center Grand Traverse Bay, Great Lakes Children's Museum, and Traverse Area Community Sailing—100% SF (Leelanau County)
