Proposed budget range of \$30K-60K is recommended (Simpson/Smith)

Stadium Blvd Project Update - The Ann Arbor Art Center has formed a committee to review proposals and help direct the project; they've been meeting regularly. Currently, the Call for Artists has been published by the Ann Arbor Art Center in early July and the call will close on August 31, 2016. To date, the response has been good. The Art Center staff is fielding questions regarding the project and the City's intent. The notice of the Call for Art has been published on the City's social media sites as well. The total budget for the work is \$115,000 and includes all costs such as fabrication, installation, engineering (if necessary), permits, etc.
