

AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO
EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
DIANE KOSKI AND THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, with offices as 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48107-8647 (“City”) and Diane Koski (“Employee”) agree to amend the employment agreement dated May 2, 2011, as follows:

1) Paragraph 2 is amended to read as follows:

2. Employee shall receive as compensation for the covenants to be observed and services to be performed as set forth above, an hourly rate of \$15.00 for services accepted by the City as meeting the standards under the contract. The total compensation under this amended contract will be \$15,600 for a total not to exceed *\$39,000.00*. Employee will work on days and hours agreed upon by Employee and the Finance Services Area Administrator, or his designee. Employee will not work any hours in excess of 40 in any week unless those hours are approved in advance by the Finance Services Area Administrator. Employee will be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in connection with this contract. It is understood and agreed between the parties that the compensation stated above is inclusive of any and all remuneration to which the Employee may be entitled.

2) Paragraph 3 is amended to read as follows:

3. This agreement shall be in effect from May 2, 2011 through *June 30, 2012*, or until exhaustion of the *\$39,000.00* maximum compensation, whichever comes first, unless terminated earlier under Paragraph 4.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the original agreement between the parties effective May 2, 2011, unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this Amendment Number One and are made a part of this amendment as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This Amendment Number One to the agreement between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns to the parties.
