

**CITY OF ANN ARBOR ELECTION COMMISSION**  
**June 10, 2011 MINUTES**

The City of Ann Arbor Election Commission Meeting was called to order by the City Clerk, Jacqueline Beaudry, at 2:00 p.m., in the Council Work Room, Guy C. Larcom Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, MI, 48104.

The members present were City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry and Police Chief Barnett Jones. City Attorney Stephen Postema was absent.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**NEW BUSINESS**

City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry updated the Election Commission on the plans for redistricting the City wards. Maps of the draft boundary changes were provided. The city clerk stated the changes were very minor and adjustments were made in the downtown area to keep the geographic shape of the wards consistent with the City Charter requirement for "pie shaped boundaries" from the center of the city. Changes were required due to the increased population in the First Ward following the release of the 2010 Census numbers.

Jones moved, seconded by Beaudry, that the Election Commission recommend the draft ordinance be approved by City Council as presented by staff.

On a voice vote, the Chair declared the motion carried.
