...Whereas, The MDEQ has promised the City and Washtenaw County that the cleanup criterion for 1,4-dioxane would be lowered from [83] 85 ppb to 7.2 ppb - a cleanup criterion more consistent with current science, which indicates that levels closer to 3 ppb are appropriate; ...
