Budget Presentation

Staff will provide a brief overview of the FY24 budget and transportation items, specifically. The Transportation Commission will have the opportunity to review and ask questions regarding the transportation elements of the FY23 Proposed Budget.

Shared Micromobility Discussion with Spin

Spin has operated a fleet of shared dockless electric scooters since April 2019 – currently 400 e-scooters operate within Ann Arbor. This fleet was augmented with 100 shared dockless electric bicycles in April 2023. A representative from Spin will give a presentation of their operations in Ann Arbor and answer Commissioner questions.

Equitable Engagement

The City of Ann Arbor's Equitable Engagement Initiative is a multi-department, staff generated initiative, which included staff from Communications, Human Resources, Planning, Systems Planning, and the Office of Sustainability.
