PROPOSAL: The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has been advised by Mr. Joel Cavazos, Fort Worth, Texas, of his request to decommission the Pontiac Very High Frequency Omni-Directional Radio Range (PSI VOR) serving the Oakland County International Airport, Pontiac, Michigan. It will be removed without replacement.

When decommissioned, the PSI VOR would be removed from the Airport/Facility Directory, East Central 1 U. S., U. S. Terminal Procedures Publication, SC-3, Detroit Sectional, IFR En Route Low Altitude – US- L28, and IFR – Supplement United States.


