The Downtown Area Citizens Advisory Council, which works to advise the DDA and City Council about issues and opportunities that affect downtown livability, met at City Hall and over Zoom on June 6, 2023 at 7 PM.

DDA Interim Executive Director/Communications Manager Maura Thomson provided the CAC with a preview of her presentation at the semi-annual DDA informational meeting.

This was followed by a discussion of topics in our regular rotation: street closings (we love them, but we're not sure about permanent street closings on Main, State, and Liberty), parking issues (long-term vehicle storage seems a bad choice for scarce street side resources, but short-term parking opportunities remain a priority for some), and a lot of discussion about compassionate policing in the downtown area, as we await progress in the unarmed response program.
