

CONTRACT EXTENSION
BETWEEN
P.K.CONTRACTING, INC.
AND
THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

Whereas, the City of Ann Arbor, a Michigan municipal corporation, located at 301 East Huron Street Ann Arbor, MI 48104 (“City”) and P.K. Contracting, Inc., a Michigan Corporation located at 1965 Barrett Drive, Troy, MI 48084 (“Contractor”) entered into a Contract for Pavement Marking Maintenance – FY18, and

Recitals:

Whereas, under the terms of the Contract, the Contract could be extended upon proper notice and the mutual agreement of the parties for a one-year period or term for the Pavement Marking Maintenance – FY18, and

Whereas, the City having requested a one-year extension and the parties having agreed to extend the Contract for the one year period commencing July 1, 2017, and terminating June 30, 2018.

Terms:

The parties agree as follows on this 1st day of July 2017.

1. Contractor shall provide Pavement Marking Maintenance as specified in ITB No. 4450 during the July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018, extended term.
2. Contractor shall maintain, during the extension period, all insurance required under the Contract, and shall comply with all terms and conditions thereof, including but not limited to Contract Compliance requirements under City Code Chapter 112 and Living Wage requirements under City Code Chapter 23.
3. City shall pay the Contractor a total annual payment of approximately \$350,000 per year for the services to be provided under this extension agreement. Contractor to submit invoices as required under the Contract. Payments are subject to approval of the Contract Administrator.

All terms, conditions, and provisions of the Contract between the parties unless specifically amended above, are to apply to this extension and are made a part of this extension as though expressly rewritten, incorporated, and included herein.

This extension of the Contract between the parties shall be binding on the heirs, successors and assigns of the parties.
