Resolution to Accept Awarded Funds from the University of Michigan for the Advanced Transportation Technology and Innovation “ATTAIN AACE 2.0: The Ann Arbor Connected Environment Reimagined” (\$121,285.00)

Whereas, The University of Michigan is recipient of a USDOT ATTAIN federal grant in the amount of \$9.85 million to support a project entitled ATTAIN AACE 2.0: The Ann Arbor Connected Environment Reimagined;

Whereas, The University of Michigan proposes to provide the City of Ann Arbor a sub-award of its federal grant funds in the amount of \$121,285.00 to support the City’s work in support of the Project; and

Whereas, The City determined that acceptance of the sub-award of federal funds supports the economic development efforts of the City and reinforces Ann Arbor as a community with advanced research for transportation,

RESOLVED, That City Council accept a sub-award of federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration, through the University of Michigan (pass-through entity), in the amount of \$121,285.00 for the AACE 2.0: The Ann Arbor Connected Environment Reimagined; and

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator be authorized to take the necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
