### About the HHSAB

The Housing and Human Services Advisory Board (HHSAB) makes recommendations to the <u>Ann Arbor City Council</u> and <u>Administration</u>, and the <u>Washtenaw County Office of Community and Economic Development (OCED)</u> regarding policies and programs to address the housing and human services needs of low-income residents of the City of Ann Arbor.

# Responsibilities

The HHSAB is charged with the following powers and duties (as enumerated in its By-Laws):

- 1. To develop an <u>annual work plan (PDF)</u>, which shall detail the Board's role in implementing the City's housing and human services policies and programs.
- To provide feedback in developing the Consolidated Strategy and Plan and Annual elements required by the <u>Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)</u>.
- 3. To make recommendations to City Council regarding City housing and human services policies.
- 4. To make recommendations annually to City Council regarding funding priorities for the expenditure of federal, state, and City allocations and grants for housing and human services.
- 5. To oversee the HUD-mandated citizen participation process to assess community housing and human service needs.
- To review proposals for <u>Ann Arbor Affordable Housing Fund (AAAHF)</u> funding requests over \$25,000 and make recommendations to City Council and the Mayor for final approval.

7. To recommend two (2) members to represent the City on the <u>Coordinated Funding</u> program operations funding review committee.
