Public Services

Barton Dam embankment work and public access restrictions to begin in March. In early March 2025, Barton Dam construction work will begin in Ann Arbor, restricting public access to certain areas of the adjacent Barton Pond, Barton Nature Area, Bird Hills Nature Area and trails to and along the Huron River. This planned, required work will include stabilizing a berm on the downstream slope of the right embankment to address seepage and stability concerns and is projected to be completed by June 2027.
