Jackie,

Just a heads up that there will likely be a couple of proposed amendments to agenda item C-1, An Ordinance to Amend Sections 4:60 and 4:61 of Chapter 49...

Although any CM is free to amend as they see fit, the suggested language is to add the following amendment to Section 4:60(12) Penalties as (b)(iv):

The fines for a single-family dwelling, two-family dwelling, or townhouse dwelling unit located on a non-residential zoned parcel shall be the same as R1 residential property.

The other suggested amendment is to add the following to Section 4:61(1). Because that paragraph is already pretty long, it could become its own paragraph inserted after (1), which would require renumbering of the current (2).

The notice shall contain information directing residents with disability or other access needs to contact Community Standards for potential assistance, including from programs that pair residents with volunteers to assist them with snow removal.
