I have reviewed the current draft and have read most of the comments that have been posted so far and it's clear from the comments that most people are not in favor of the plan as it stands and feel it will not achieve its goal. I simply want to add that I agree with that assessment and am not in favor of approving the plan as it is. I have lived in Ann Arbor for over 40 years and, up until recently, have loved living here. Over that last few years, though, there have been many changes (like replacing the surface lots around Kerrytown with high-rise, expensive housing) that have lowered the overall quality of living in my mind. This is particularly true for retirees. The goals of the CLUP may be well intended, but there is no way the current plan is going to achieve those goals without ruining the city for the majority of the existing residents. I see the CLUP as simply making the city less desirable to live in for most of us.
