- Founded in 1999
- Ongoing partnership between the TheRide, Ann Arbor DDA, and the City of Ann Arbor
- Collaborates with City of Ann Arbor Transportation and OSI











# Program Highlights Spring 2023 - Spring 2024

- Surveyed downtown commuters and employers to learn how services can better suit their needs
- Ran three challenges to encourage, amplify and reward alternative commuting
- Supplied 200+ employers (and counting) with go!passes

#### 2023 Commuter and Employer Surveys

Completed by Level 7, the study sought to understand and measure of commute behaviors and the impact of AAATA's getDowntown Program. The results were compared against results from a 2018 study where possible and appropriate.

#### Sample:

The survey was distributed to various employers in downtown Ann Arbor and employees (commuters).

Employers n=97 (2018 survey had 77 respondents)

Commuters n=199 (2018 survey had 380 respondents)

#### **Field Dates:**

Employers: 4/4/2023 - 4/24/2023

Commuters: 4/10/2023 - 5/10/2023





## World Car-Free Challenge

- Kickoff at A2Zero Green Fair
- September 22-29, 2023
- Collaboration with City of Ann Arbor
- Participants exceeded:
  - ✓ 200 miles by walking,
  - √300 miles by carpooling,
  - √800 miles by biking, and
  - ✓ 1,000 miles using local buses.

- 53,560 gallons of fuel saved compared to taking conventional vehicle
- 503 tons of GHG saved by bus trips compared to midsized vehicle
