As someone who walks and drives past Bloom marijuana clinic daily, I want to bring up a problem with traffic and Bloom parking. Clients come and go constantly, and park in front of the building. The front of the building is not laid out for safe exiting by motor vehicles. There are constantly problems with vehicles backing out onto Miller and interfering with traffic and pedestrians. There are lots of near accidents, and occasionally, actual accidents. Bloom is near a curve in the road, and some people on Miller exceed the speed limit a bit. Backing out onto a road as busy as Miller is a bad idea.

Sometimes, clients southbound on Spring stop at the stop sign at Miller and wait there, in the middle of Spring, until a spot opens up, blocking people from leaving the neighborhood. Just had that situation again a couple days ago.

I request the Planning Commission prohibit parking in front of Bloom. I also request Bloom use planters or some other barrier so clients won't be tempted to park there anyways. Perhaps, the west curb cut could be eliminated, also.
