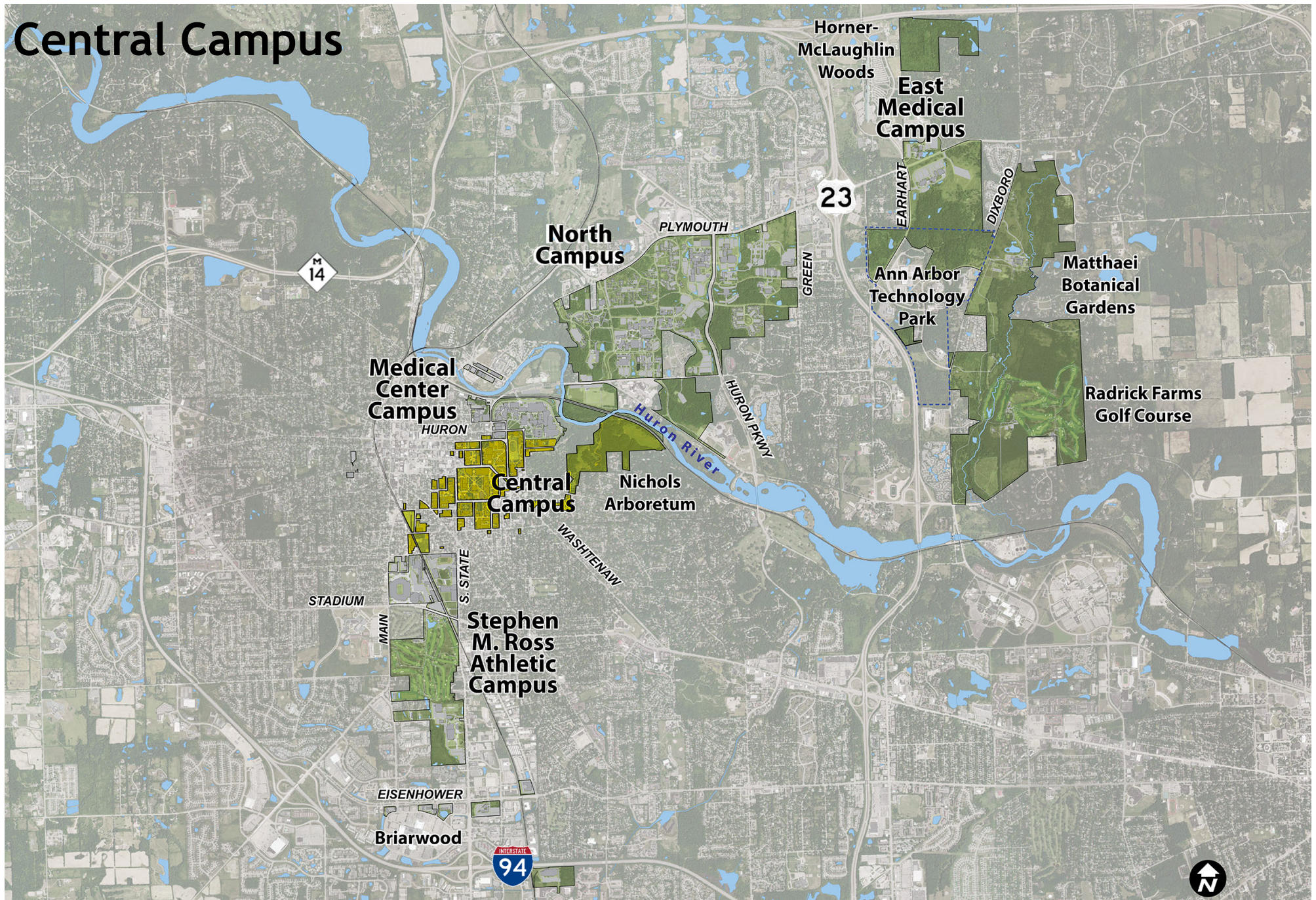

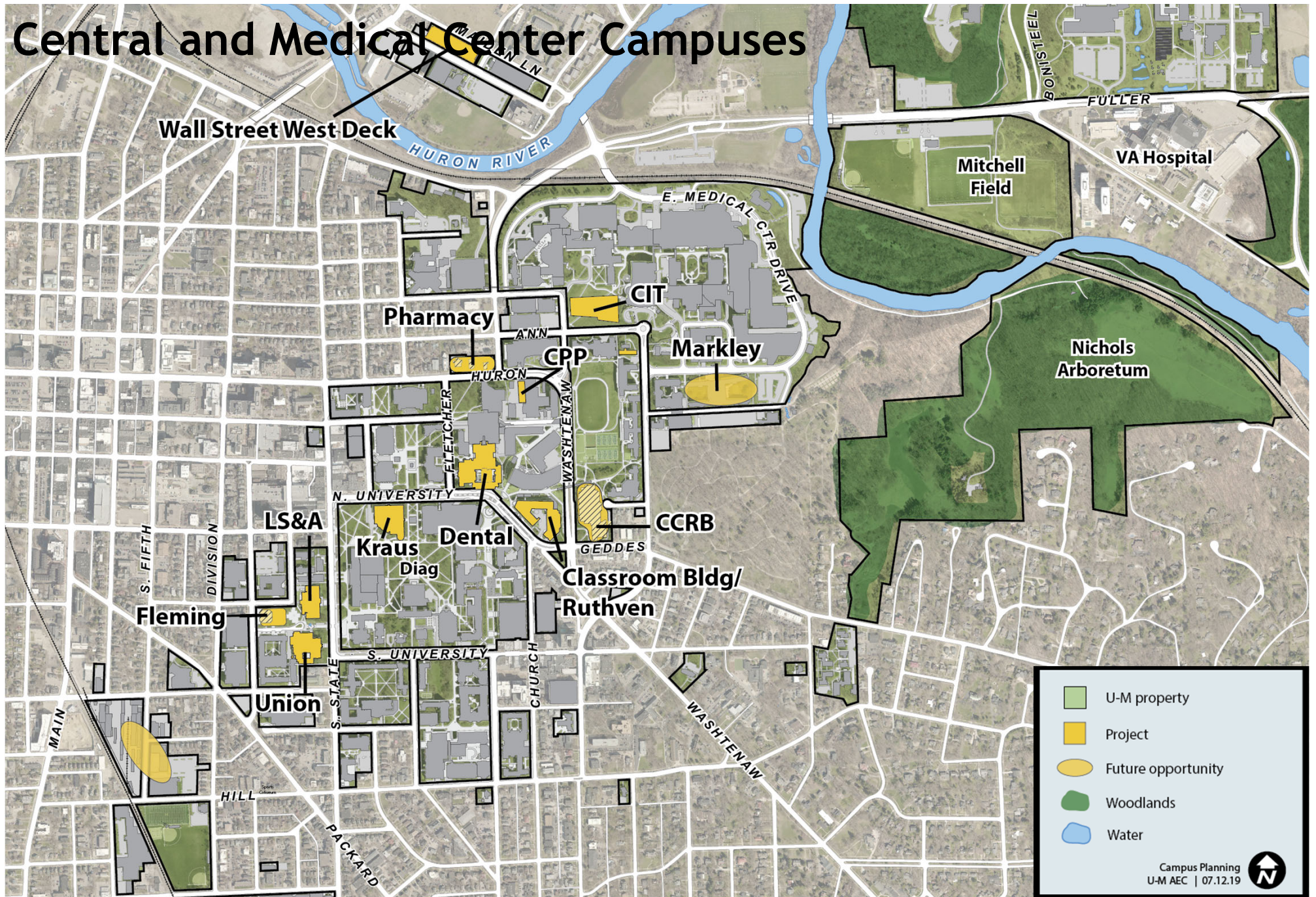

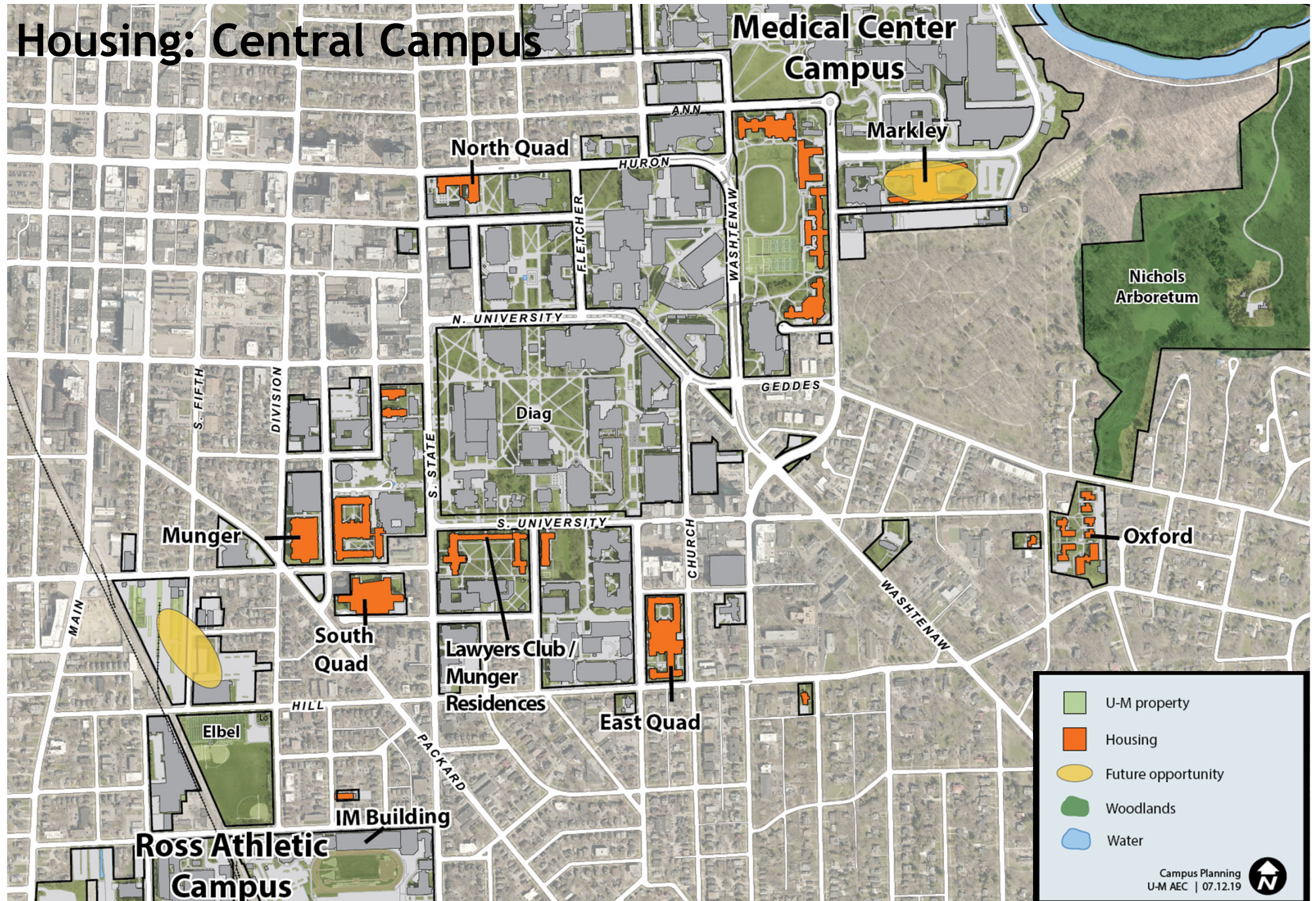


Existing Housing: Central Campus

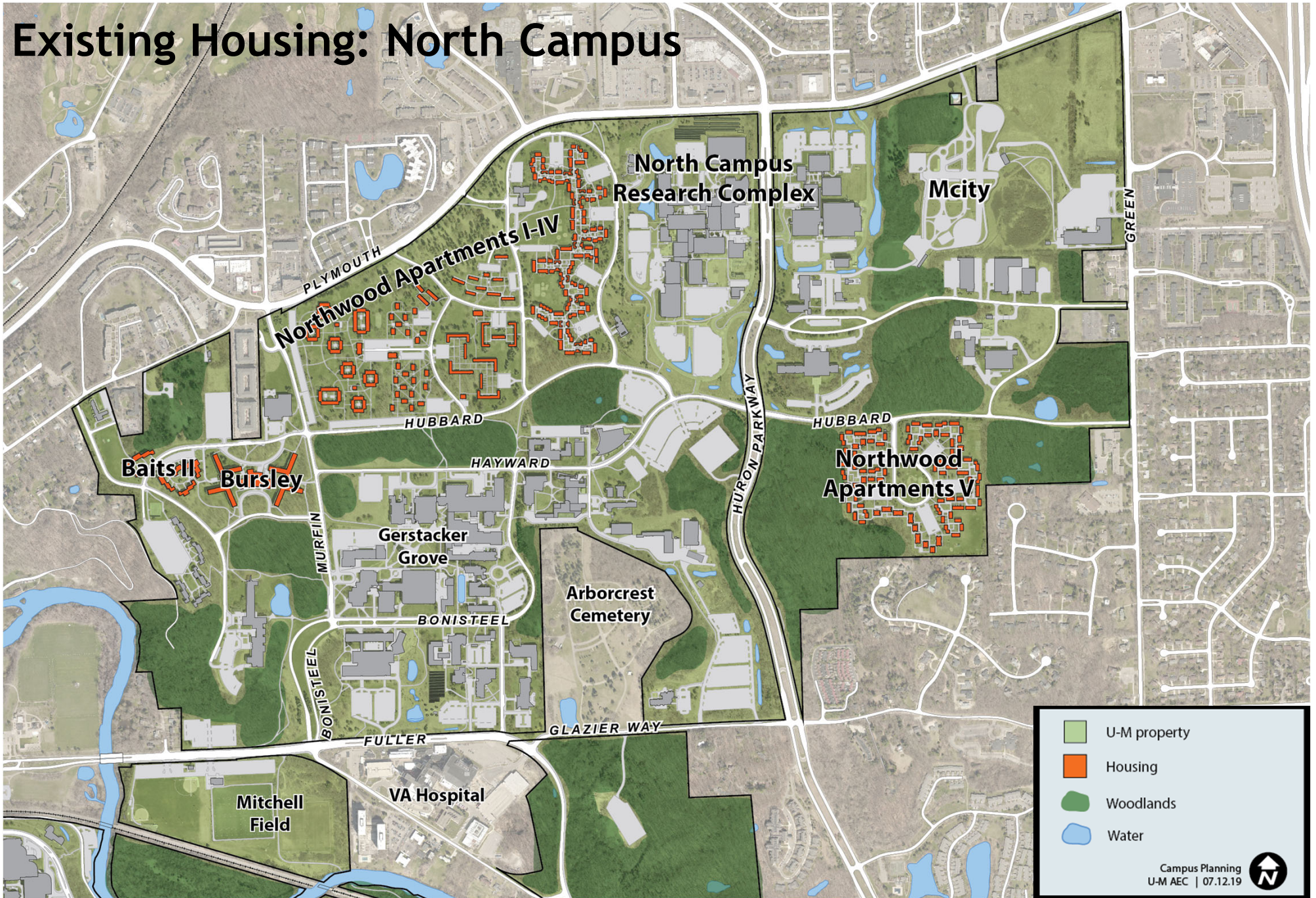

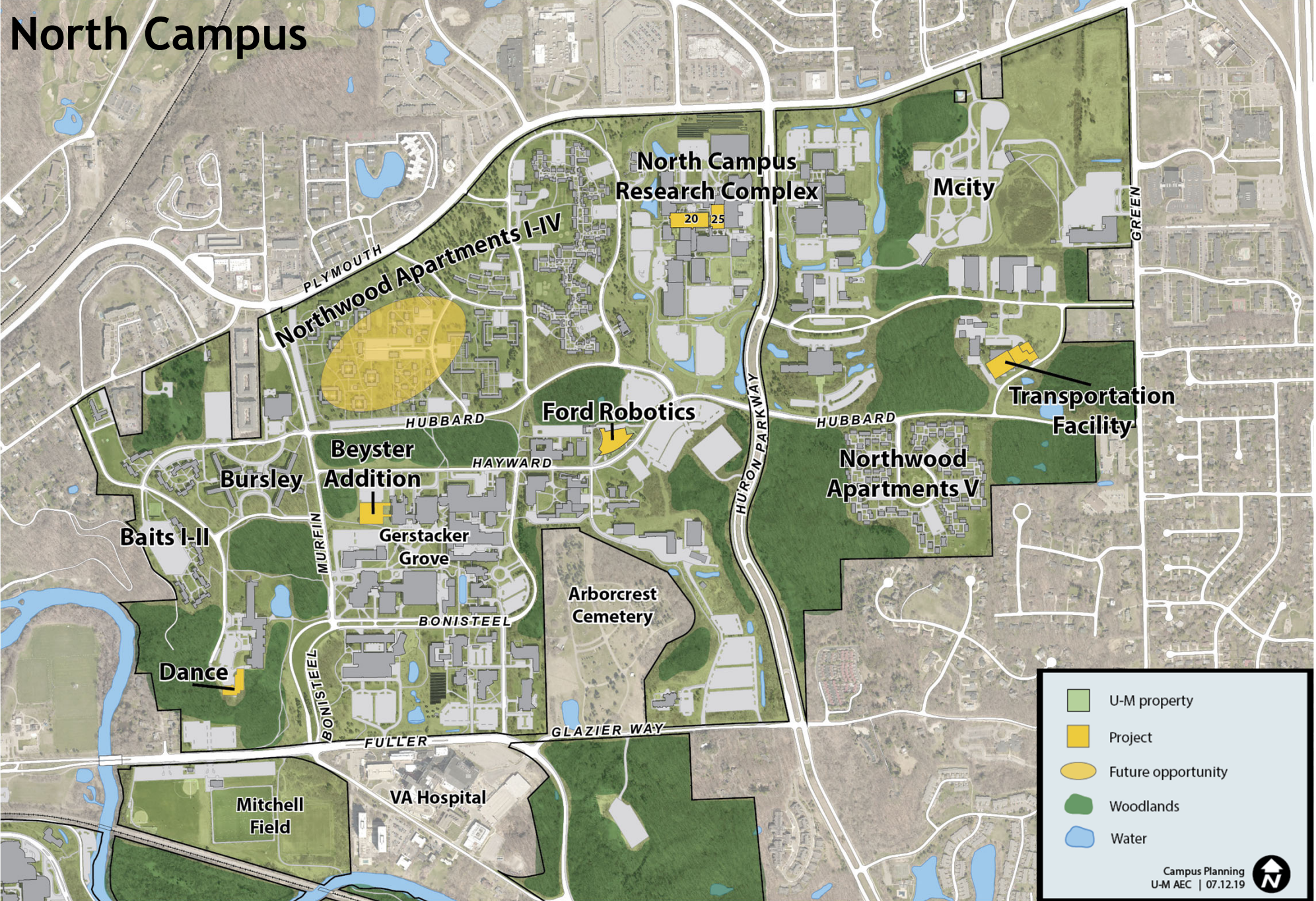
Housing: Central Campus
