Dear Council Representatives and City Planning Commission,

I am a recent home buyer in the Lansdowne neighborhood at 636 Wembley Ct. and am writing in regards to the Lamberth Road connection from the proposed condo development at 2250 Ann Arbor Saline.

I am in favor of the proposal as stated in the Planning and Development Services Staff Report dated December 02, 2014. I think that the "Knox Box" solution is the best compromise and that the Planning Commission has made the right decision. The residents of the condos and clearly emergency responders need multiple avenues to enter or exit the property as efficiently as possible. However, we do not want the access to become a general purpose shortcut from Scio Church to Main or vice versa. I think this isn't in the interest of the future condo owners nor is it in the interest of Lansdowne residents. I strongly oppose any sort of "open" access even if it is hindered by speed humps and much prefer the limited security access gate option.
