

2010-2019 Detailed Pedestrian Crash Review

A Supplement to the 2020 Annual Crash Review, October 2020

The Transportation Commission requested a detailed review of 2019 pedestrian crash data to provide a better understanding of the circumstances contributing to crashes. This crash analysis supplements the September 2020 Annual Crash Report and will provide the following:

- Summary crash statistics for 2015-2019
- List 10 intersections and segments with the most crashes during 2015-2019
- Summary of overall findings
- List of all pedestrian crashes from 2019 with summarized events

Summary Crash Statistics

The summary crash statistics provided in this report are based on those reported in 2015-2019. The summary statistics are pulled from a five-year crash analysis in order to have a larger data set with which to work. The following data are presented as reported from Roadsoft. Data were filtered to limit results to incidents tagged as pedestrian and crashes occurring on public streets with a National Functional Class of local, collector, or arterial. Freeways and private street were excluded from the data set.

Temporal crash conditions were reviewed to determine if there are significant differences from overall crash performance. Temporal conditions include month of year, day of week, and time of day.

Pedestrian crash occurrences are concentrated in September through April. Pedestrian crashes concentration coincides with months that have fewer hours of daylight and higher levels of university based travel activity.

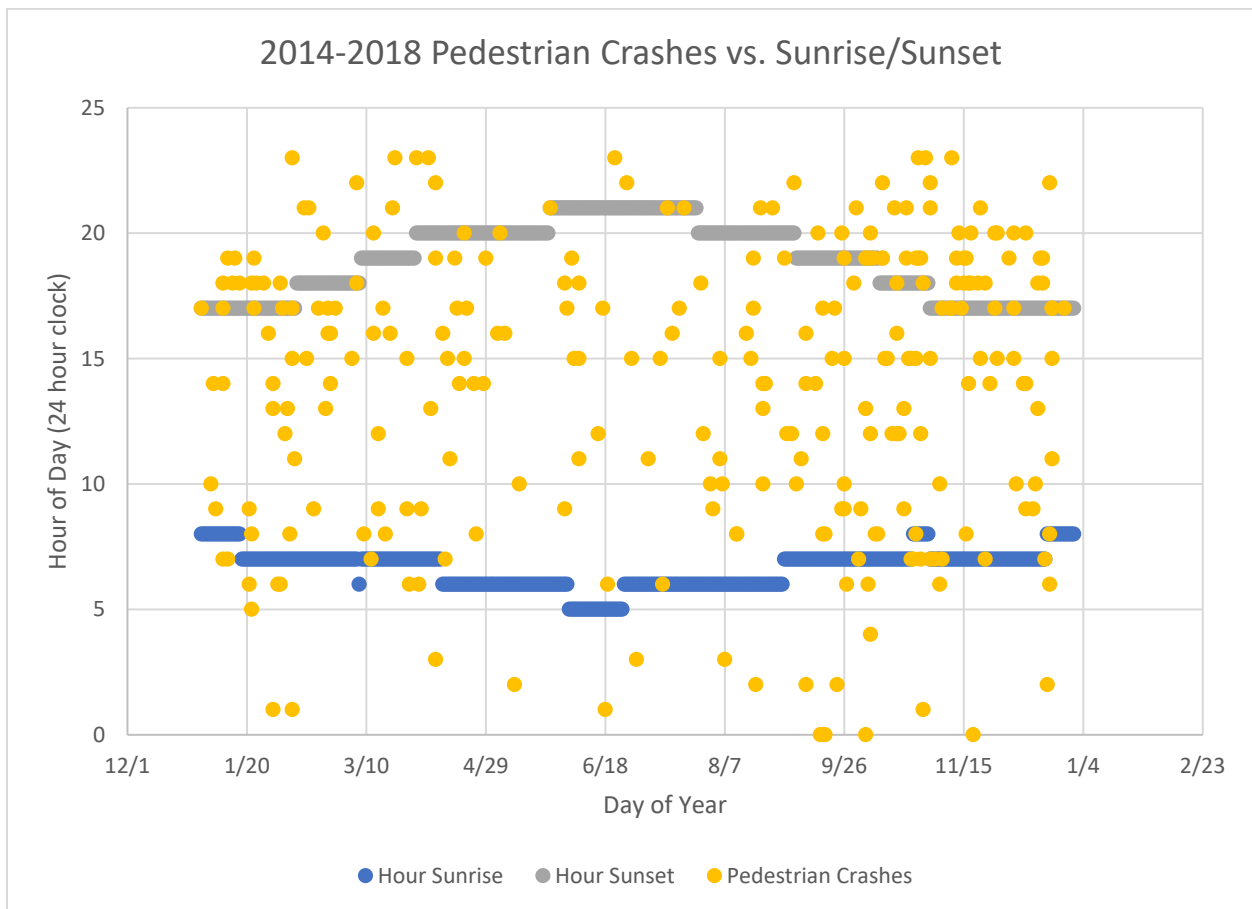
The day of week distribution of pedestrian crashes is consistent with the overall crash pattern experienced throughout the City. Crashes are fairly evenly distributed across weekdays with slightly lower numbers of crashes experienced on the weekend.

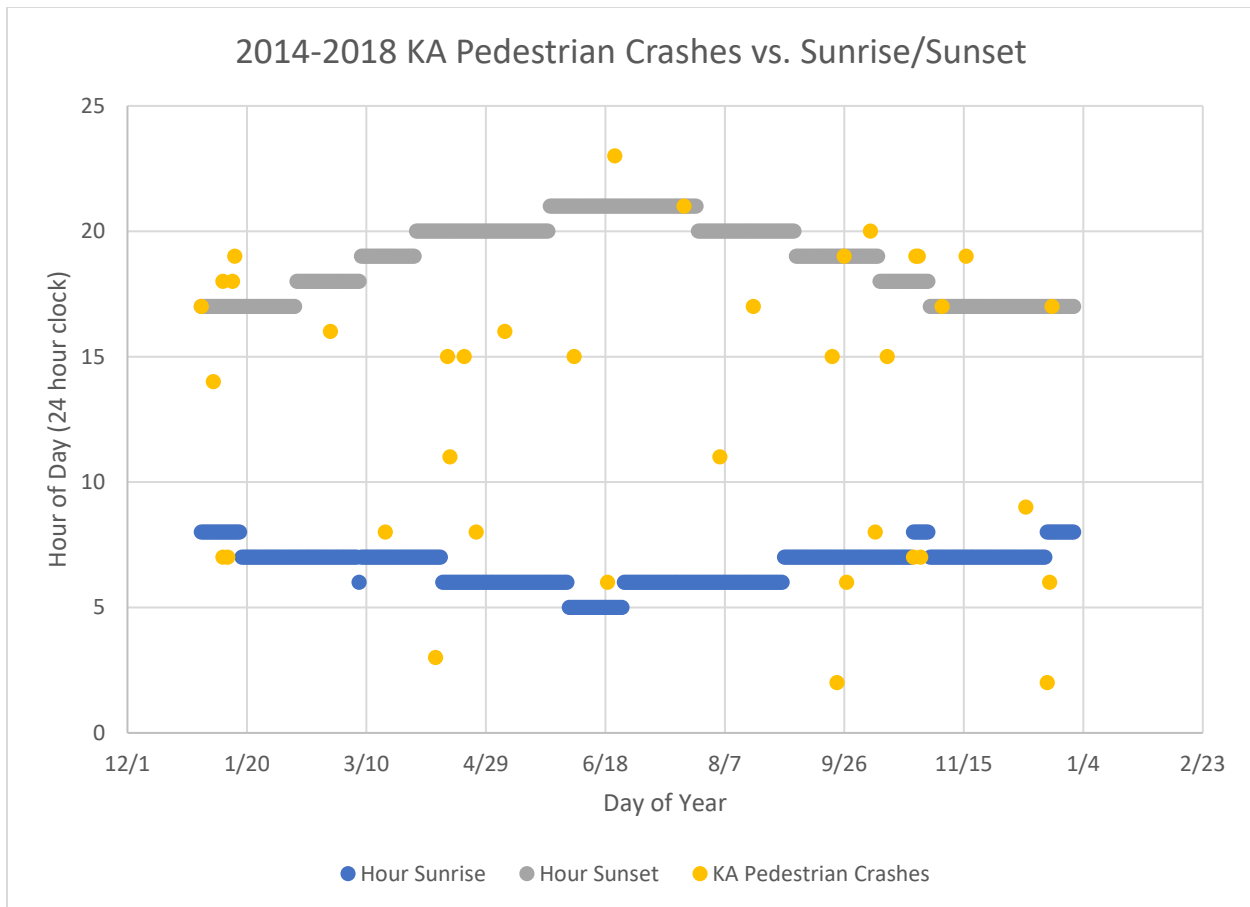

The time of day a crash occurs can greatly influence conditions around a crash. For instance, hours of darkness can greatly impact a driver's ability to see a pedestrian.

The hourly distribution of pedestrian crashes is consistent with the overall distribution of crashes. Fewer crashes occur during the overnight and morning hours. Crashes are more concentrated in the hours between 3PM and 8PM. The highest concentration of occurrences is between 5PM and 8PM.

The following graphs show crash data for 2014-2018 graphed against sunrise and sunset to provide a better understand of how crashes are distributed.





High Crash Locations

The Transportation Commission requested additional information regarding the location of crashes. The City currently has a variety of methods staff use to monitor where crashes occur. Currently staff consult the following resources:

- [Mobility in Ann Arbor Factbook](#): The factbook was developed as part of the ongoing transportation plan update. The factbook identifies the tier I & II priority corridors and intersections for safety improvements in the City.
- [SEMCOG High Priority Safety Locations](#): SEMCOG (the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments) produces these maps identifying areas of regional safety concern. They are useful in understanding how our network is performing in the context of the region.
- Roadsoft: Roadsoft has network scanning tools that enable a ranking of intersections based on the number of incidents that occur at those locations or street segments based on the number of incidents that occur per mile. (Roadsoft uses the Michigan certified data set that is also available through www.michigantrafficcrashfacts.org or the SEMCOG mapping tools.)

The following tables provide the locations for high pedestrian crash incidence (raw number of crashes) intersections based on all crashes or serious injury crashes. The ranking was developed through Roadsoft. Rankings are based on the 2015-2019 pedestrian crash data set as described above.

Intersections under the jurisdiction of the Michigan Department of Transportation are marked with an asterisk (*).

Overall Summary of Findings

Staff conducted a detailed review of crash reports for all pedestrian crashes that occurred in 2019.

Following this section, you will find a listing of each crash including a summary of that crash.

Transportation Commission members specifically requested the crashes be reviewed for crash locations, age of vulnerable road users and vehicle type. Limitations in the data set have prevented a review of all crashes by vehicle type as the coding category is too broad for personal vehicles. Additionally, age data was not available for all the redacted crash reports engineering staff has access to. Based on the available data we can ascertain the following:

- Crashes involving a driver striking a pedestrian were limited to individuals in personal vehicles.
- Some incidents involved commercial vehicles and busses, but these were unusual and did not result in a general trend.
- Crashes involved pedestrians and drivers of all ages.
 - A significant concern of the Transportation Commission members was the number of incidents involving youth, defined as under 18. Two crashes involved youth pedestrians (10 & 14, 3%). One crash involved a youth driver (17, 1.5%).
 - Many of the crashes involved pedestrians aged 20-29.
- Inattentiveness was a contributing factor to many of the crashes.
 - Limited information was available for driver distraction. Distractions were only listed if the driver admitted to being distracted or if a witness had provided a statement.
 - Many of the drivers reported not seeing the pedestrian. In many cases it is difficult to determine if not seeing was based on a limitation or the failure to look for pedestrian.
- 30% of the reported crashes from 2019 included a pedestrian that was struck by a turning vehicle approaching from behind the pedestrian.
- 3% of the reported crashes involved a turning vehicle striking a person in a wheelchair.
