Yes, based on results from the Stormwater Modeling project, the proposed Fiscal Year 2018-2023 Capital Improvements Plan includes an Edgewood/Snyder Stormwater Improvements project. The project is proposed for design in FY19 (begins July 1, 2018) with construction in calendar 2020.
