(2250 ANN ARBOR-SALINE ROAD)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP, BEING A PART OF CHAPTER 55 OF TITLE V OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR

The City of Ann Arbor ordains:

Section 1. THE ZONING MAP, which, by Section 5:4 of Chapter 55 of Title V of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is made a part of said Chapter 55, shall be so amended as to designate the zoning classification of property described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 5, T3S, R6E; thence Easterly along the North line of Section 5, 984.9 feet; thence deflecting 90°53' to the right 718.12 feet to an iron pipe for the Place of Beginning; thence deflecting 79°06' to the left 493.10 feet; thence deflecting 32°12' to the right 394.72 feet to the centerline of Saline Road; thence deflecting 90° to the right 264.28 feet along the centerline of the Saline Road; thence deflecting 90° to the right 195.82 feet; thence deflecting 40° to the left, 449.67 feet; thence deflecting 86°54' to the right, 398.00 feet to the Place of Beginning. Except for East 60 feet along and Northwesterly of the centerline of Ann Arbor-Saline Road in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan as R4B (Multiple-Family District) **WITH CONDITIONS, in accordance with the attached Conditional Zoning Statement of Conditions which is hereby adopted and incorporated herein.**

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after ten days from legal publication.
