

1A	West Medical Drive	April 13 – May 1, 2026
1B	West Medical Drive / Intersection of Zina Pitcher & Ann Street	May 4 – May 8, 2026
2A	Zina Pitcher Place / Catherine Street	May 11 – June 6, 2026
2B	Zina Pitcher Place / Catherine Street	June 8 – July 3, 2026
3A	Ann Street / Observatory Street	July 6 – August 1, 2026
3B	Ann Street / Observatory Street	August 3 – August 15, 2026
