AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1:17 (CODE VIOLATION CITATIONS) OF CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE I AND SECTION 8:458 OF CHAPTER 104 (ENERGY AND WATER BENCHMARKING) OF TITLE VIII.

The City of Ann Arbor ordains that Section 1:17 of Chapter 1 of Title I and Section 8:458 of Chapter 104 of Title VIII of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor be amended as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Section 1:17 (Code violation citations) of Chapter 1 of Title I of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is amended as follows:

1:17. Code violation citations.

<u>Section 2</u>. That Section 8:458 of Chapter 104 (Energy and Water Benchmarking) of Title VIII of the Code of the City of Ann Arbor is amended as follows:

8:458. Violations and enforcement.

- (1) A violation of any provision of this chapter is a civil infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 for a first offense, and not more than \$1,000.00 for each additional or subsequent offense, plus the costs of prosecution including court costs. Each act or violation and every day upon which any such violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense. The court may issue and enforce any judgment, writ, or order necessary to enforce this chapter.
- (2) Knowingly submitting a false benchmarking report or submitting it with reckless disregard for the truth and accuracy of it and/or the data on which it is based is a civil infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 plus the costs of prosecution including court costs.
- (3) Remedies not exclusive. In addition to any remedies provided in this chapter, any equitable or other remedies may be sought.

<u>Section 3</u>. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction shall hold any provision of this Ordinance invalid or unenforceable, such holding shall not invalidate or render unenforceable any other provision thereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon legal publication.
