Thanks for your prompt reply. After I quickly scrolled through the link you sent just now, I stand corrected as to you, and to a lesser extent as to CMs Disch and Akmon. I had wrongly assumed that relevant materials would routinely be attached to a public hearing agenda. I'm still underwhelmed as to the lack of detailed engagement on what is, after all, the primary responsibility of council. And it looks to me that we really don't have a serious commitment to efficiency, and that city government will, going forward, be driven in large part by looking for increases in tax revenue and fees (the list of user fees increased by 20-35% is truly amazing) and sales of assets to cover a relentless increase in the number of FTEs. Unfortunately, that likely will not leave much room for actual programs of any substance to help residents in need.

The amendment is the addition of the following language to the authorizing resolution:

RESOLVED, the contract shall be amended to include provisions that require the contractor to provide the names of all craft laborers who will work on the project and sufficient evidence that each of them have completed the prescribed OSHA safety training requirements prior to work commencing on the project; and that failure to provide such evidence shall constitute a breach of contract;
