E. Social Equity and Sustainability – 20 points

1. A statement from the bidder as to what percentage of its workforce resides in the City of Ann Arbor and in Washtenaw County, Michigan. The City will consider in evaluating which bids best serve its interests the extent to which responsible and qualified bidders employ individuals in either the city or the county. Washtenaw County is prioritized for evaluation purposes for this solicitation.
2. Evidence of Equal Employment Opportunity Programs for minorities, women, veterans, returning citizens, and small businesses.
3. Evidence that the bidder is an equal opportunity employer and does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, pregnancy, age, religion, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, height, weight, or disability.
4. The bidder's environmental record, including findings of violations and penalties imposed by government agencies.

F. Fee Proposal - 15 points

Fee schedules should be submitted in a **separate, sealed, envelope** as part of the proposal.

Provide pricing (**unit price per tree planted**) and quantities for all tree species bidder can acquire. ***Pricing provided shall be valid for the length of the contract.***
