Subject: American Rescue Plan Funds Survey

Ann Arbor will receive one-time funding of \$24 million from Congress' passage of the federal American Rescue Plan Act. This allocation will be used to fund eligible projects within the city, as an effort to recover from the impacts of COVID-19.

The city has been engaging the community since January as part of the process to identify which projects will receive funding, with informational videos, a series of online/Zoom Q&A sessions — including an upcoming **Q&A session 6 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 9, via Zoom** — and a community-input survey, which launched Jan. 28, available at a2gov.org/a2opencityhall through Feb. 14. Please join us on Feb. 9 to ask any questions about potential projects, and complete the online survey to let decision-makers know which projects you would recommend to be funded.

A recommendation will be made to Ann Arbor City Council who, in March, will determine how to spend the \$24 million.
