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Hello Ms. Briggs and Ms. Cornell,

I was thrilled to see the new language for the ELO and RTR on the agenda tonight. I think it's a huge step forward in making the law operate more as it was intended. In particular, I am very very excited that landlords would not be allowed to present any offer until 150 days into the leasing period.

My biggest concern is the language in section 3. I do not think this language prevents landlords from doing what my landlord did this year. I think landlords will still be able to say (on day 150), "sign in 5 days or the rent will go up by x". This is not "requiring the tenant to accept an offer" technically.

I strongly urge you to figure out how to prevent such behavior, or I do not believe these changes will make much of a difference in real world application.

My suggestion would be to strengthen the language of that clause to something like, "any offer made to tenants must remain valid (or decrease) for at least 30 days." I'm sure you have lawyers who can help you write something better.
