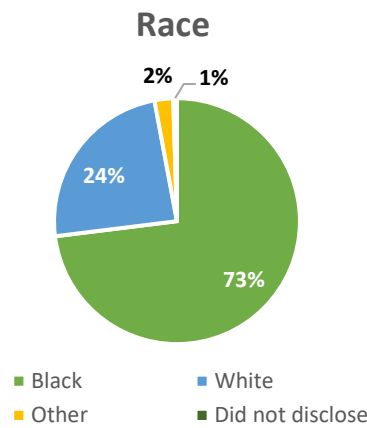

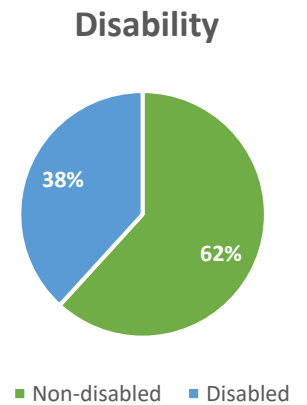

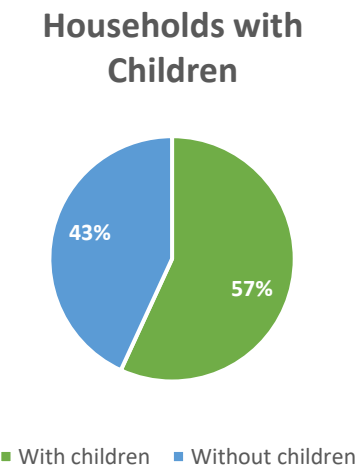

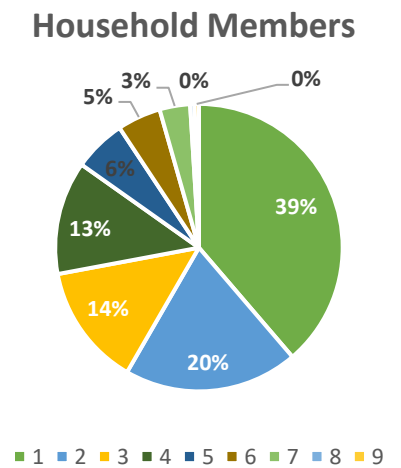

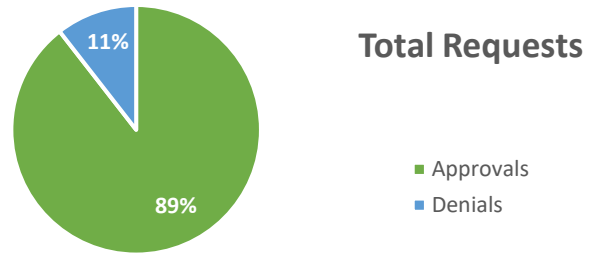

*Applications were denied because **AAHC was unable to make payments to owner** or funds were already exhausted.

***\$136,000** from City of Ann Arbor and **\$160,000** from Ann Arbor Housing Development Corporation (includes \$6,800 in administrative costs)

**Disbursements covered 99% of total past due rent owed by all applicants (\$288,122/\$291,871).

**98% of accepted applicants had all their past due rent covered by the City of Ann Arbor disbursement.
