Also a part of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 33, bounded as follows: Beginning at the SW corner of the NW quarter of Section 33, T. 1 S., R. 4 E., thence North four chains fifty links, thence East eleven chains of two links, thence South parallel to the West line four chains fifty links, thence West along the quarter line eleven chains, thence North to the place of beginning, containing five and 1/4 NW quarter of SW quarter of the parcel marked Private Park, A-1 indicated.

Witness all of us by these presents, that we, Alexander W. Hays, John I. Rose, and John V. Sheehan (children) or representatives, and May H. Hays and Cora Rose, their wives, have caused the plat in the annexed plat to be surveyed, laid out and plotted, to be known as Hamilton, Rose and Sheehan's Addition to the City and Town of Ann Arbor, and that the streets and alleys in shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.
