Although the current Trinitas plan, Cottages at Barton Green, meets requirements of R4A Zoning, I urge you to vote against the proposed project. This project would have negative impacts on traffic in the area including the Barton Drive & M14 ramps; increase risks to pedestrians and bicyclists; and reduce property values because the Trinitas plan doesn't follow the city's master plan for developing the site which isn't owned by Trinitas but is city property.
