Comprehensive Plan Review - The Ann Arbor City Planning Commission and Planning & Development Services Unit review the City Comprehensive Plan on a regular basis. The City Comprehensive Plan consists of several plans, or "elements," that work together to describe a vision for the City's future and guide decisions about its land use, transportation, infrastructure, environment, housing, and public facilities. The adopted plan elements can be found on the City's website at www.a2gov.org/compplan. As part of an annual review, the Planning Commission is seeking comments about the City Comprehensive Plan, including elements that should be studied for possible change or new elements that should be added to the Plan.
