DR25-0001; 300 West Huron: The proposed project is located at 300
West Huron on the corner of West Huron and First Street, zoned D2
Downtown Interface. The 57,879 square foot five-story building will be a
111 room limited-service hotel. The main lobby entrance is at the corner
of West Huron and First Street. Primary building materials will be brick
veneer and fiber cement panels. The project will have a single driveway
from First Street for solid waste access only and will have no on-site
vehicle parking.

PROJECT PRESENTATION:

Brandon Chaney of Nederveld and Nitin Patel of Elevate Architects, presented the proposed project request.

The Design Review Board discussed the design plan for the proposed 300 West Huron Street development project on February 12, 2025. The Design Review Board proposed the following comments and recommendations for this site plan application:

- Encourage more interesting design for pedestrians, perhaps by including detailing in the brick work, more interesting windows, marguees
- Consider the treatment of the ground floor windows for both privacy in guest rooms and to enhance the pedestrian experience
- Bring the windows all the way to the corner to meet one another
- · Find ways to bring natural light into corridors and stairs
- Confirm that there will be a cantilevered canopy over the primary entrance at the corner of W Huron and First streets
- Note the opportunity to add architectural details and elements in the metal panels on the upper stories, below the hotel logo (proposed along the First Street elevation)
- Add additional street trees and think about underground soil conditions to encourage the growth of these trees
- Reduce the amount of pavement as much as possible and add greenery or planting to soften the design

City Planner Mariana Melin-Corcoran shared the ordinance to dissolve the Design Review Board will be going before the City Planning Commission on Wednesday, February 19, 2025.
