STAFF PRESENTATION:

Noting no speakers, the Chair declared the public hearing closed.

Moved by Commissioner Steve Kaplan seconded by Commissioner **Chip Smith that:**

I move that the Commission issue a certificate of appropriateness for the application at 553 South First Street, a contributing property in the Old West Side Historic District, to construct a 52 square foot rear addition with a balcony on top; replace the door to the balcony; infill one of two front doors and replace the remaining door; remove an attic exhaust fan in the rear gable and replace it with a circular window; infill a second-floor rear window and

install a new window nearby; infill a basement window under the front porch; install a backyard patio; and construct two new accessory structures. As proposed, the work is compatible in exterior design, arrangement, texture, material and relationship to the rest of the building and the surrounding area and meets The Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings, in particular standards 2, 5, 6, 9, and 10 and the guidelines for building site, addition, roofs, and windows, as well as the Ann Arbor Historic District Design Guidelines, in particular the guidelines for additions, doors, lighting, and residential accessory structures.
