It seems clear of the face of it: if you lease 190+ parking spaces to a private enterprise, out of 750+ total spaces created for public benefit, you are allocating about 25+% of the benefit of the public subsidy to the private enterprise, well above the 10% limit specified in the bond. What slight of hand bookkeeping makes that not so?
