1. Workplan Review:

Green Rental housing ordinance enforcement process

Goes to council in March, maybe get an update at the March meeting (~15 mins)

Improve resources to assist renters with accessing information on STREAM with the goal of helping renters make more informed choices about where they choose to live.

- Someone in the city may be making a video to teach people how to use it (Rental housing services?)
 - Need to contact someone within the city about current resources for how to use STREAM
- Can we get even more data? Eviction data, fair housing violations, other complaints?
 - New dashboard with more rental housing data
 - Put on agenda for February meeting
 - o Modify STREAM or make a new dashboard?

- Meet with rental inspection services AND Stream company (or rep within the City [Anna])
- Schedule extra TEC session to discuss this topic

3. Sublease Education:
