

**CITY OF ANN ARBOR ELECTION COMMISSION
JULY 16, 2013 MINUTES**

The City of Ann Arbor Election Commission Meeting was called to order by the City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry at 4:40 p.m., in the Council Work Room, Guy C. Larcom Municipal Building, 301 E. Huron Street, Ann Arbor, MI, 48104.

The members present were Police Chief John Seto and City Clerk Jacqueline Beaudry. City Attorney Stephen Postema was absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Seto moved to approve the minutes as presented. Beaudry seconded the motion and on a voice vote, the motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Seto moved, seconded by Beaudry, that the proposed list of Election Inspectors for the August 6, 2013 City Primary Election be approved as presented. On a voice vote, the motion carried.

INFORMATION

Election Commissioners discussed the large turnout in the Presidential Election 2012 and discussed possible solutions for managing even-year voter turnout at the polling places, including possibly splitting some precincts.

City Clerk Beaudry stated the Clerk's Office is looking into modifying the boundary of the 5-4 and 5-5 precincts as one is larger than the other and with both voting at Slauson Middle School, a slight shift in the boundary would be a solution to the lopsided turnout.
