

Amendment One
to the
Michigan Economic Development Corporation Grant
with
City of Ann Arbor

This Amendment One (the “Amendment”), dated April 18, 2025, is to the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (the “MEDC”) Grant with City of Ann Arbor (the “Grantee”), CASE-401468 (the “Agreement”).

Under the Agreement, the MEDC provided the Grantee with funding assistance to create new, universal access splash pad to celebrate the City’s connection to water as part of the Ann Arbor Bicentennial Celebration, which will enhance the quality of life for underserved communities and provide a bridge between those communities and additional city services and amenities, and increase equity and inclusion in City of Ann Arbor parks.

Pursuant to Section XVI of the Agreement, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Section II of the Agreement to delete “March 31, 2025” and replace with the following “March 31, 2026”.
2. Delete Section XXIX of the Agreement in entirety and replace with the following:

“XXIX. **SURVIVAL.** The terms and conditions of sections VII, VIII, XI, XV, XVII, XXI, XXII, XXIII, XXIV, XXVI, and XXVII, and XXIX shall survive termination of this Agreement.”

Except as specifically provided above, the Parties agree that all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in effect.
