Hello -

During the May 19 planning commission meeting, I was on the telephone line during the public comment period regarding the Greenhills School project. After the in-person attendees were given an opportunity to speak, the chair asked whether there were any remote comments. He was told that no one on the Zoom connection had raised their hand; I was waiting on the phone line, and was not recognized to speak. I'm very disappointed that participants waiting on the phone line were not afforded an opportunity to comment.

To be clear: I am fully in support of the Greenhills Project. Greenhills is a wonderful school and neighbor. (I live on Concord Pines Drive, immediately to the south of Greenhills.) I would also point out that Greenhills School predates the Earhart Village condominium development by several decades: while I recognize that some residents of those condos expressed reservations about traffic, their choice to move in next to a school that has been operating since 1967 mitigates the weight that should be afforded those concerns.

I wish I had been given an opportunity to express my view in greater detail and am disappointed in the management of public comments at this meeting.
