The Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) will hold a pre-hearing to consider DTE Electric Company's (DTE Electric) March 29, 2019 application for approval of its Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) under MCL 460.6t through its defined Proposed Course of Action (PCA). DTE Electric requests that the Commission: 1) find that it does not have a persistent capacity need for the next ten (10) years; 2) pre-approve its proposed Energy Waste Reduction (\$103 million in projected EWR capital costs in 2020-2022), Demand Response (DR) and Conservation Voltage Reduction and Volt-Var Optimization (CVR/VVO) capital costs, commencing within three years following the Commission's approval of the Company's Integrated Resource Plan (\$24 million of projected DR capital costs beginning May 1, 2020 through December 31, 2022, which is incremental to the DR spend requested in DTE Electric's current rate case, U-20162; and \$0.7 million in cumulative capital costs for the CVR/VVO program from 2019 to 2020, related to the CVR/VVO pilot); and 3) grant DTE Electric other relief.

Any person wishing to intervene and become a party to the case shall electronically file a petition to intervene with this Commission by April 19, 2019. Donofrio, One Energy Plaza, Detroit, MI 48226.

Any person wishing to appear at the hearing to make a statement of position without becoming a party to the case may participate by filing an appearance. To file an appearance, the individual must attend the hearing and advise the presiding administrative law judge of his or her wish to make a statement of position. All information submitted to the Commission in this matter becomes public information, thus available on the Michigan Public Service Commission's website, and subject to disclosure. Please do not include information you wish to remain private.
