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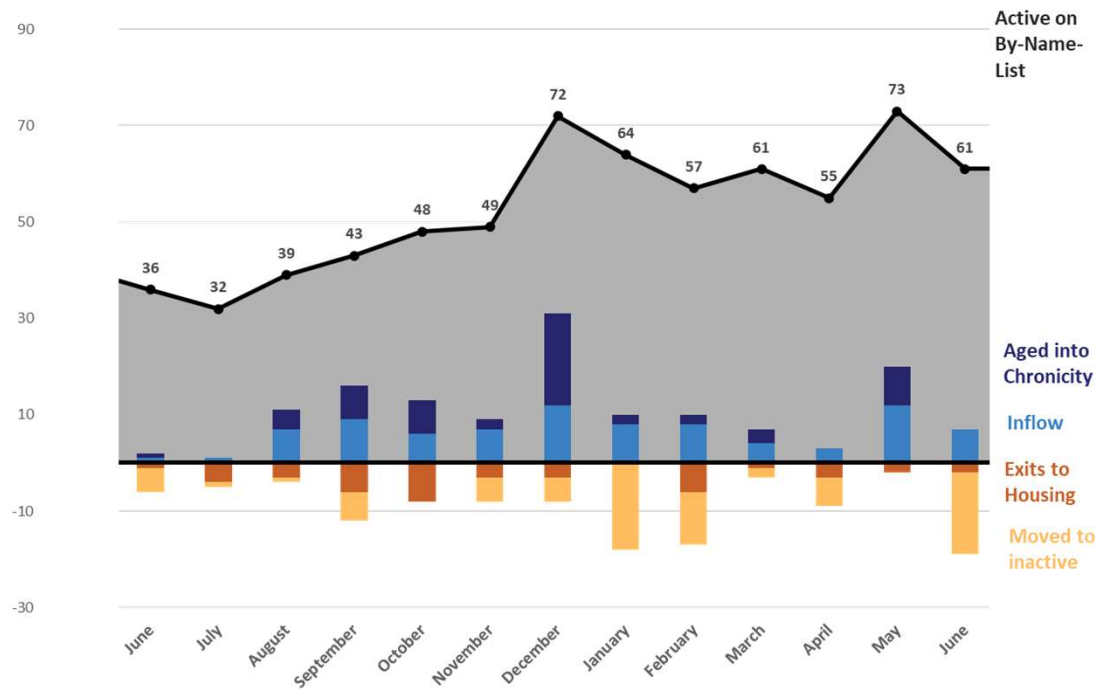

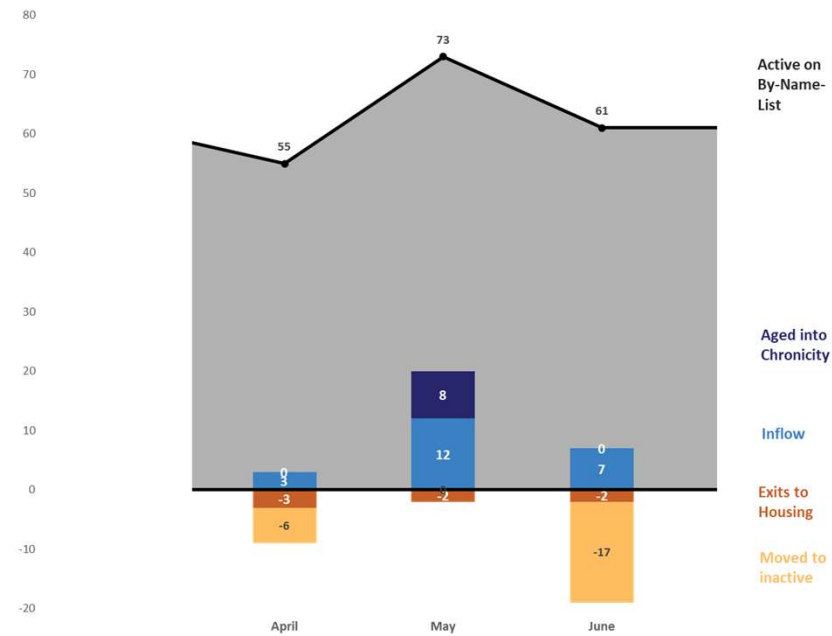

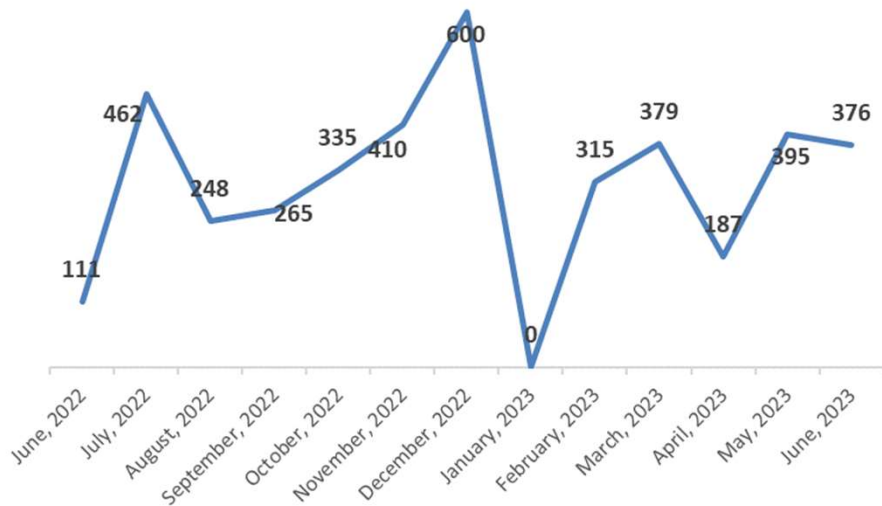

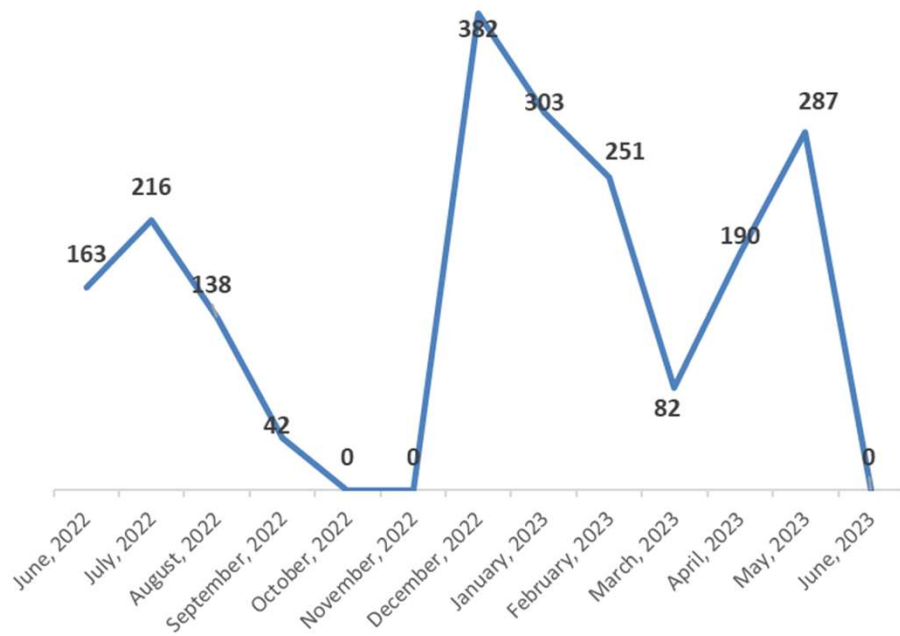

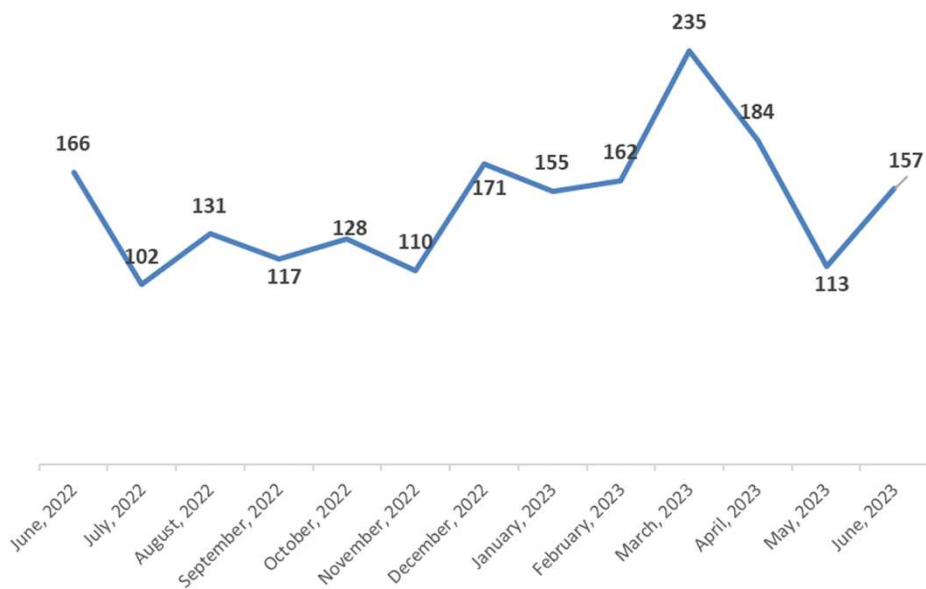

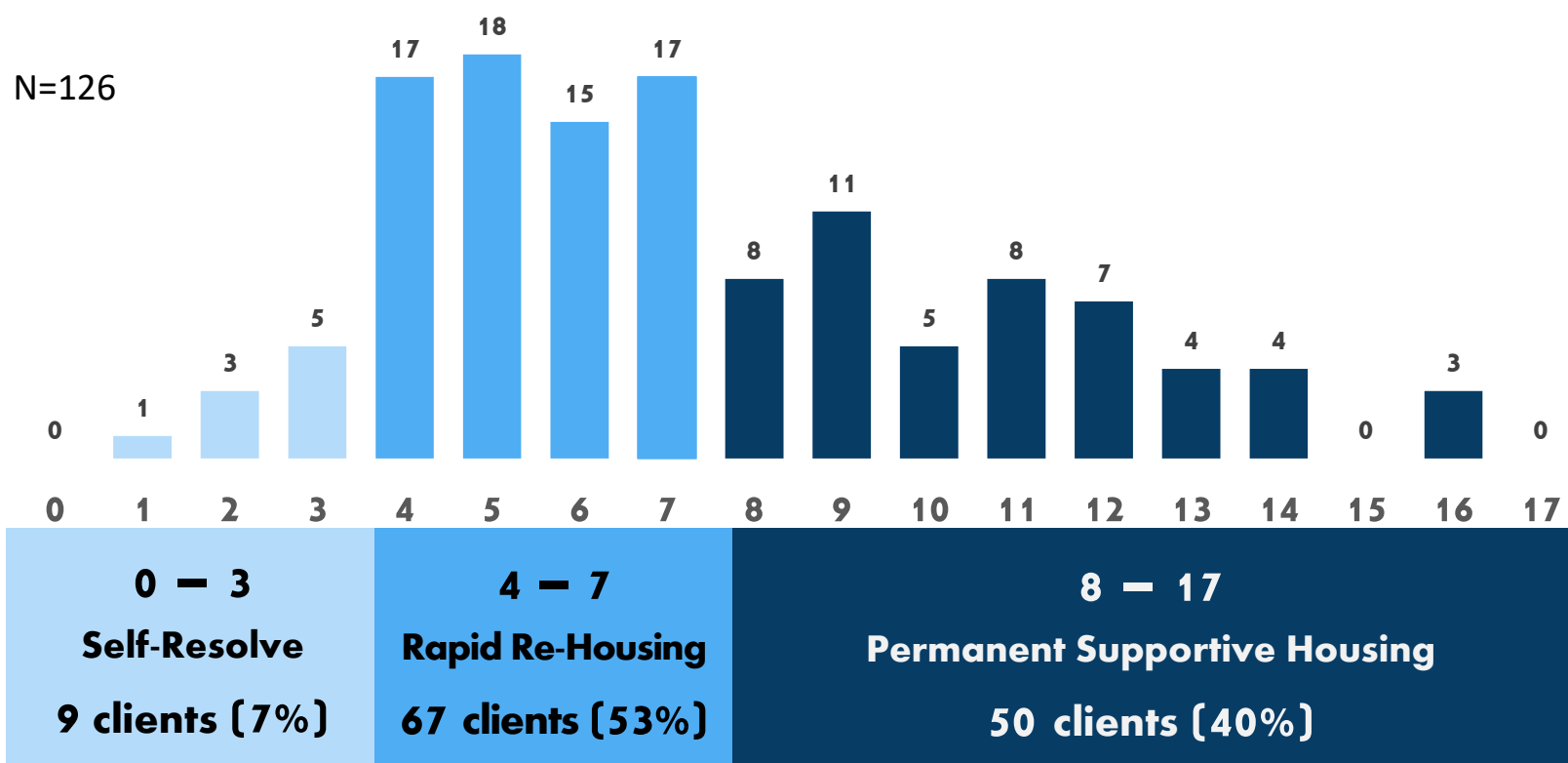

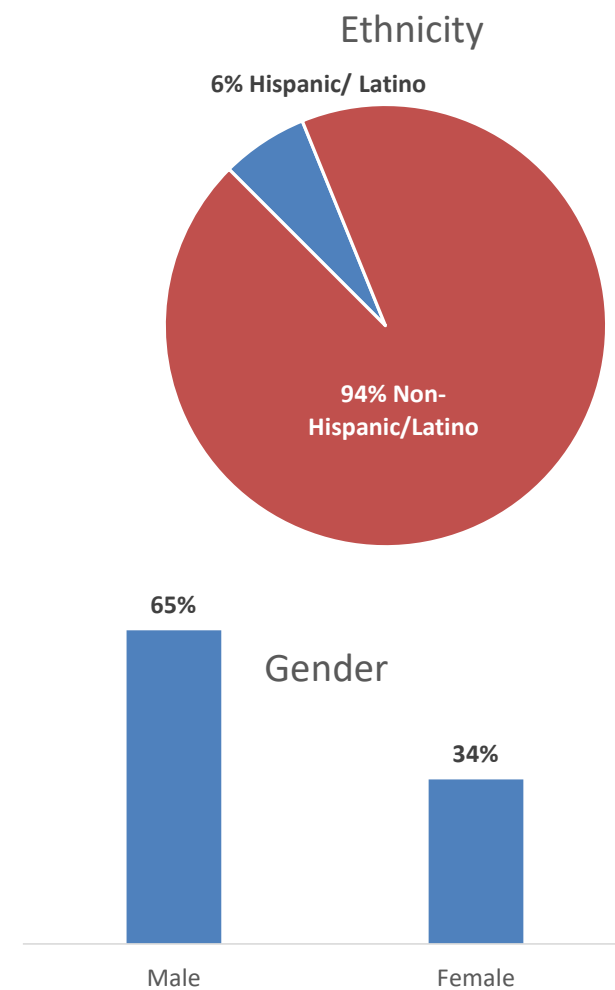
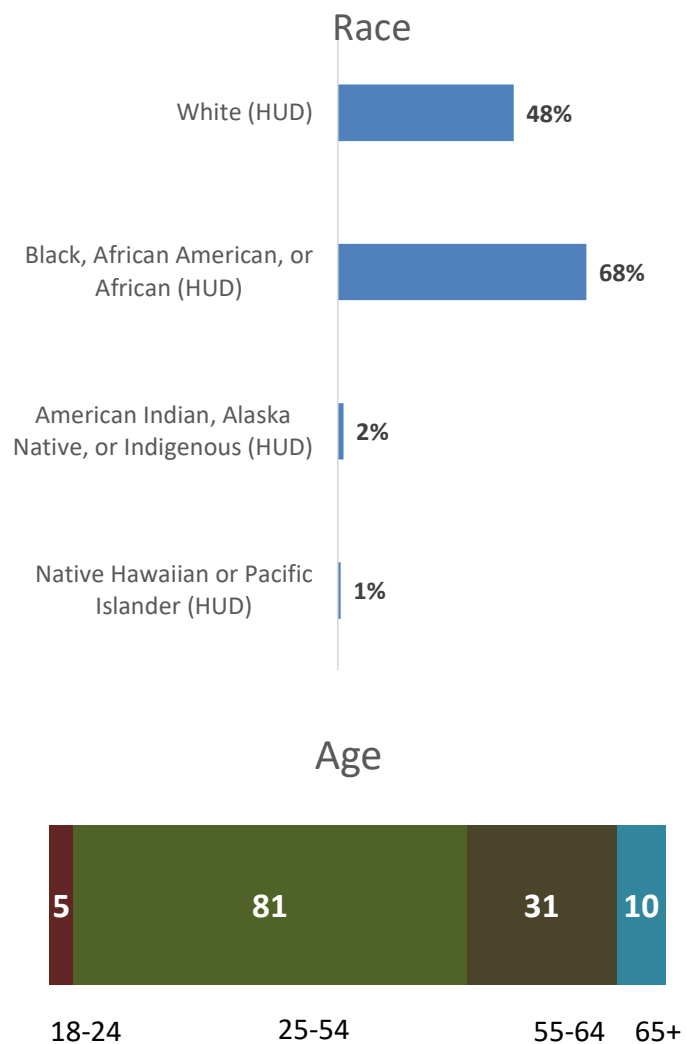
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## Individual VI-SPDAT Scores: April—June, 2023



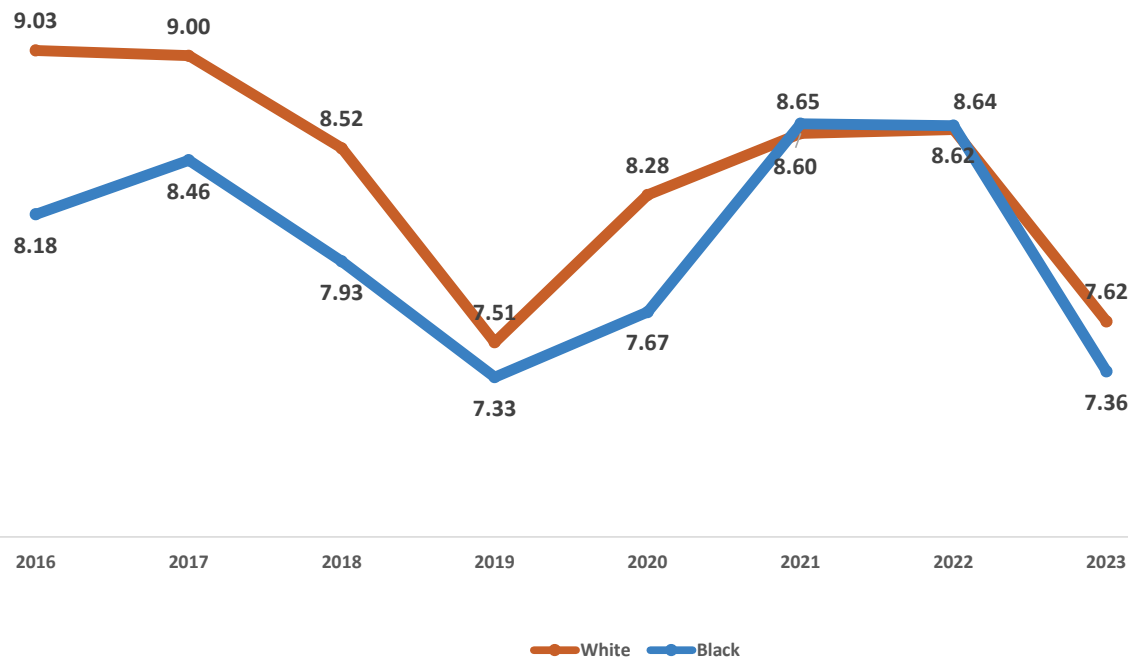

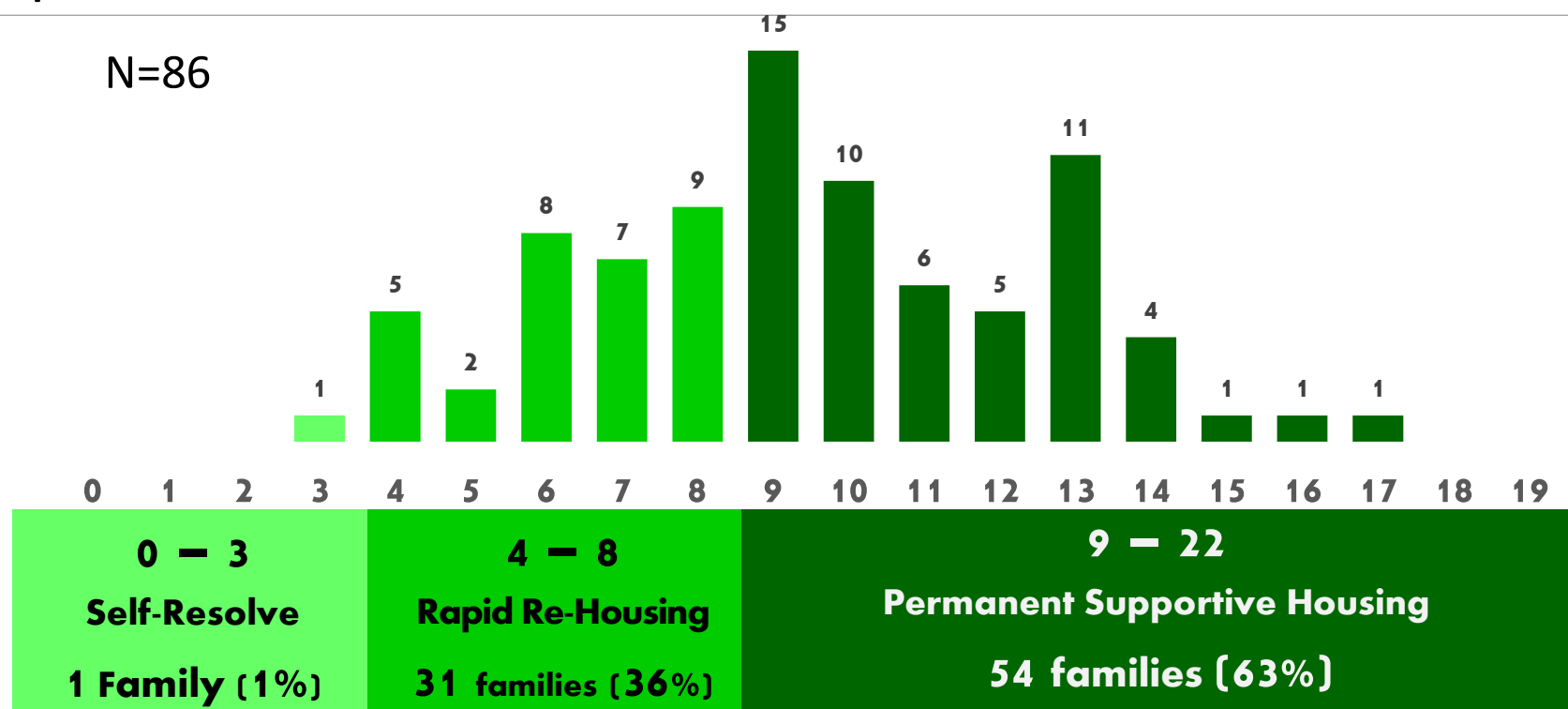
# Individual VI-SPDAT Scores: Racial Disparity Over Time

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Remarkably, since 2021 we have observed the near elimination of a racial disparity in assessments, although there is a small discrepancy of .25 in 2023.

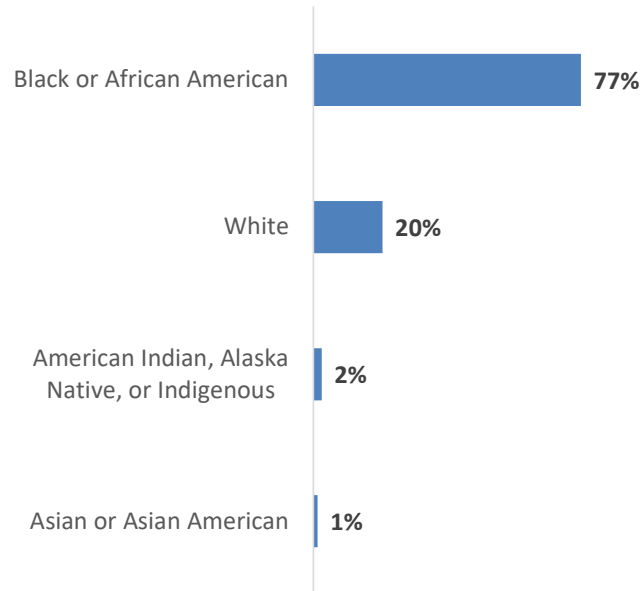
## Family VI-F-SPDAT Scores: April to June, 2023



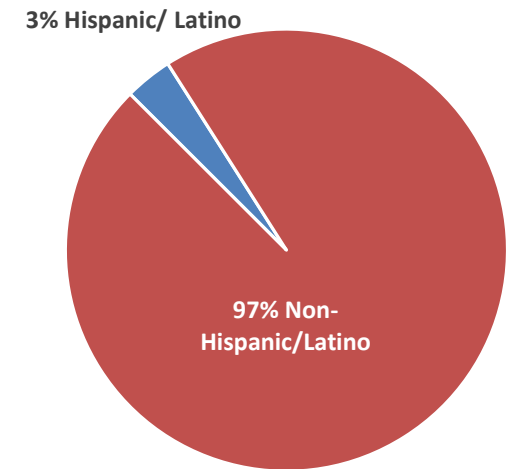

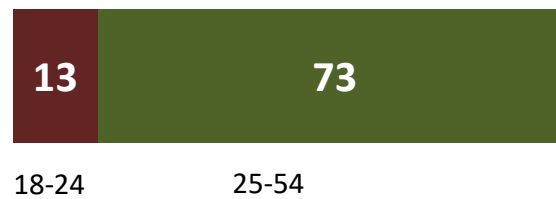

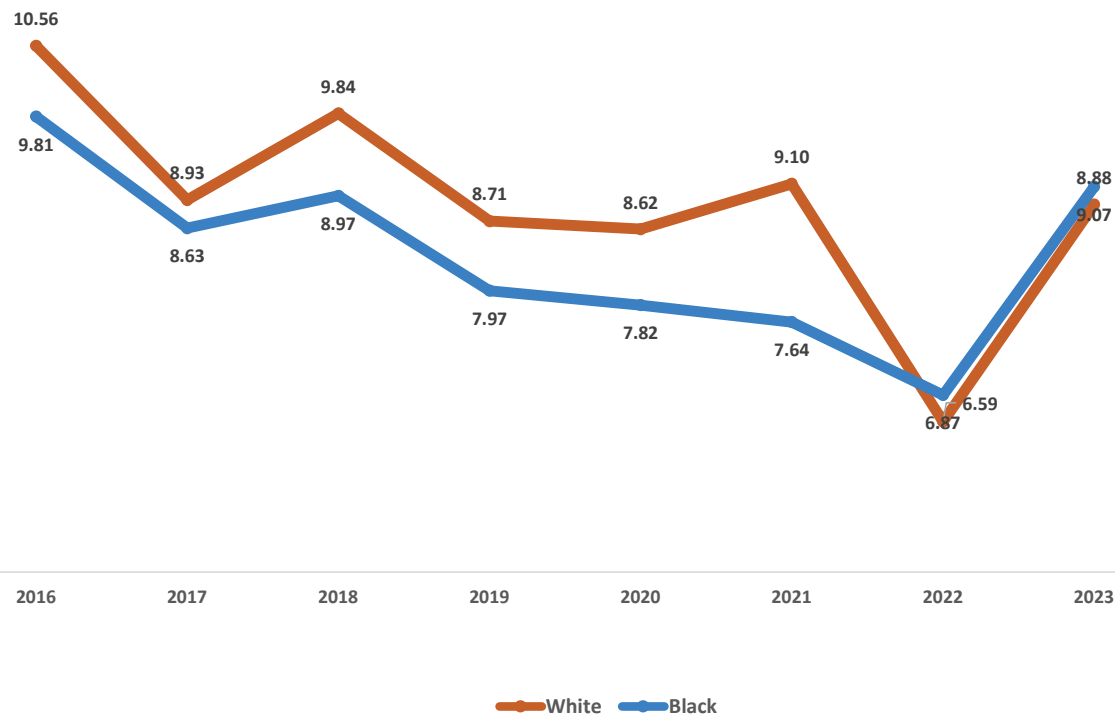

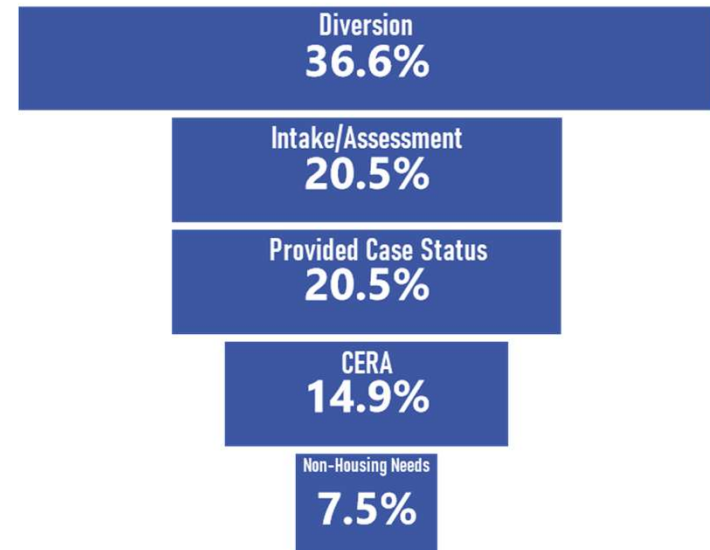
