

Housing and Human Services Advisory Board 01/13/16

Resolved by A. Erickson (Support: E. Pollack) upon review of the City of Ann Arbor-Ann Arbor Housing Commission Joint Policy and Financial Advisory Committee ("Committee") Recommendations to City Council, the Housing and Human Services Advisory Board:

- Supports the recommendations of the Committee that the City of Ann Arbor support the Ann Arbor Housing Commission agency and its operation through the conversion of public housing units via the RAD process and beyond
- Recommends that financial support be supported exclusively through general fund appropriations, without diversion of any general fund appropriations to the Ann Arbor Affordable Housing Fund or Community Development Block Grant (supporting Community Based Development Organizations (CBDO)); as to meet the City's Affordable Housing goals as identified by the adopted Housing Affordability and Economic Equity Report will require increased resources
- Recommends that if diversion of general fund appropriations from the Ann Arbor Affordable Housing Fund to the Ann Arbor Housing Commission is necessary, the practice is only enacted for the transition period through 2018, at which time the new committee can consider longer term policies and investment implications.
