I move that the Commission issue a certificate of appropriateness for the application at 921 E Washington Street, a contributing property in the Old West Side Historic District, to install two new basement egress windows and three new windows on the front porch; replace an existing door and raise it 14" on the east elevation; replace an existing door and lower it 18" on the south elevation; install a new window in an enlarged opening on the south elevation; and approve after-the-fact siding installation done on the front porch on the following conditions: that all non-wood siding, except on the front elevated porch is repaired or replaced with wood in matching dimensions if it is deteriorated beyond repair and that the new siding is removed from the kick plate of the bay window on the East elevation and replace it with a design in wood approved by staff. The work is compatible in exterior design, arrangement, texture, material and relationship to the rest of the building and the surrounding area and meets the Ann Arbor Historic District Design Guidelines, especially those for windows, doors and safety codes, and the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings, in particular standards 1, 2, 9 and 10 and the guidelines for windows, neighborhood setting, entrances and porches, and health and safety.
