

## WEDGLE INJECTIONS

Trees and shrubs are living organisms. And that makes them no different than human beings. Just as humans need immunizations and flu shots, your trees can also suffer from serious illness and may be in need of much stronger treatment. We offer a simple, cost-effective, and non-invasive way to take care of your trees that may have "come down with something" It's called the Wedgle Direct-Inject System.

A Wedgle application differs from an insect or disease spray simply due to the fact that it's not broadly applied to the surface of the tree. Our injection system uses a needle-like injection tip that is pushed through the bark. Wedgle injections are designed to distribute the treatment into the outer active layer of the tree. Shallow injections done with the Wedgle system allow the product to move upward with the flow of sap through the tree's vascular system. Injection methods that use drilling can be ineffective and cause serious, long-term damage if the drilled holes are too deep. We use this system to protect the tree's health and prevent wounding.



## **FUNGAL INJECTIONS**

These injections are typically for plants dealing with fungal issues such as tip blight and needle cast in spruce and pine trees, or apple scab in crabapples.

## **INSECT INJECTIONS**

Borers, spruce gall and scale are generally treated with Wedgle insect injections.

## MAGNESIUM/IRON INJECTIONS

For trees suffering from chlorosis, a magnesium/iron injection is necessary to restore the nutrients to the tree.

Wedgle injections are placed 1 foot off the ground every 4-5" around the circumference of the tree.
