CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

J. Eyer reported that City Council on February 2, 2026, adopted a resolution strengthening the City's position against ICE and border control immigration enforcement in Ann Arbor. City Council declared non-public areas of city property, off-limits to ICE and border control. J. Eyer shared that City Council requested that City staff make standardized no trespassing signage available for the public. City Council resolution also addresses anti-masking policies.
