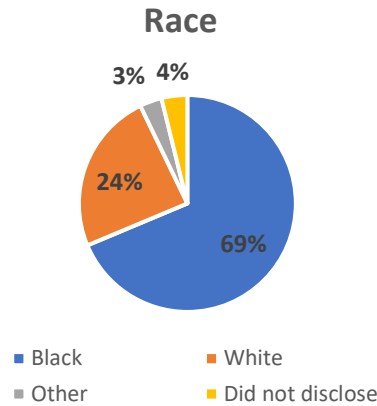

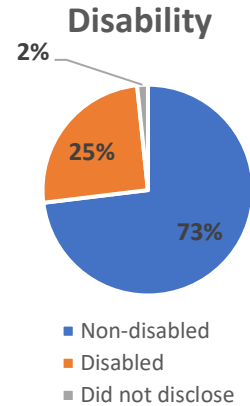

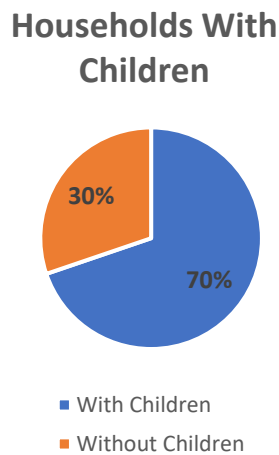

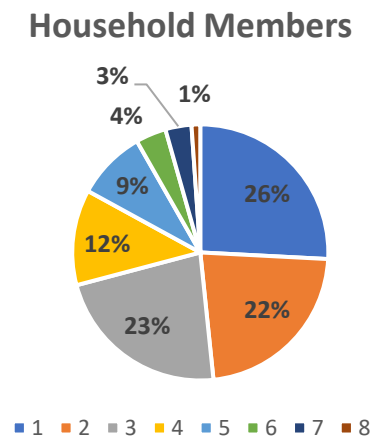

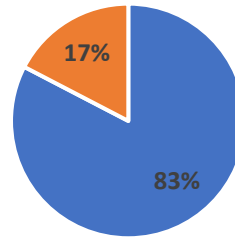

\*The most common reason for a funding request was a loss of wages or loss of employment.

\*Applications were denied because they were not living in Ann Arbor

\*\*Disbursements covered 89% of total past due rent owed by all applicants (\$319,413/\$356,910).

\*\*91% of accepted applicants had all their past due rent covered by the City of Ann Arbor disbursement.
