Hi there,

In light of the potential upcoming snow emergency, I have a suggestion related to the on-street parking bans.

For exempted streets, it would be great if after the ban has been lifted, we get notice of days and times that certain exempted streets will be plowed again. Since these streets are primarily exempted because of a lack of off-street parking, that would give people a heads up for when they should try to have their car moved, allowing the snow plows to more fully clear curb-to-curb.

Additionally, it would be great if days like today (before the predicted snow but after previous rounds that have resulted in icy street parking), we could get plows coming through for the same reason.
