Resolution to Approve Professional Services Agreements with Intertek - Professional Service Industries, Inc. for \$450,000.00; Materials Testing Consultants, Inc. for \$820,000.00; NTH Consultants, Ltd. for \$800,000.00; and Somat Engineering, Inc. for \$220,000.00 for Construction Materials Testing Services

Whereas, It is appropriate to retain professional firms to perform construction materials testing services for a variety of capital improvement projects managed by the Engineering Unit;

Whereas, In response to RFP No. 25-61 for Construction Materials Testing Services, the City received six (6) proposals and selected Intertek - Professional Service Industries, Inc., Materials Testing Consultants, Inc., NTH Consultants, Ltd., and Somat Engineering, Inc., based on their professional qualifications, past experience, work plan, and fee quotations;

Whereas, The construction materials testing services will be paid for within approved project budgets and annual operating budgets as appropriate, if so approved by City Council; and

Whereas, The firms are in compliance with the requirements of the City's Non-Discrimination and Living Wage ordinances;

RESOLVED, That the City Council approve the Professional Services Agreement with Materials Testing Consultants, Inc. (MTC) for \$820,000.00 for Construction Materials Testing Services;

RESOLVED, That the City Council approve the Professional Services Agreement with NTH Consultants, Ltd. (NTH) for \$800,000.00 for Construction Materials Testing Services;

RESOLVED, That the City Council approve the Professional Services Agreement with Intertek - Professional Service Industries, Inc. (Intertek - PSI) for \$450,000.00 for Construction Materials Testing Services;

RESOLVED, That the City Council approve the Professional Services Agreement with Somat Engineering, Inc. (Somat) for \$220,000.00 for Construction Materials Testing Services;

RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to execute said agreements after approval as to form by the City Attorney and approval as to substance by the City Administrator;

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator be authorized to approve individual work statement agreements for the duration of the contracts; and

RESOLVED, That the City Administrator be authorized to take the necessary administrative actions to implement this resolution.
