

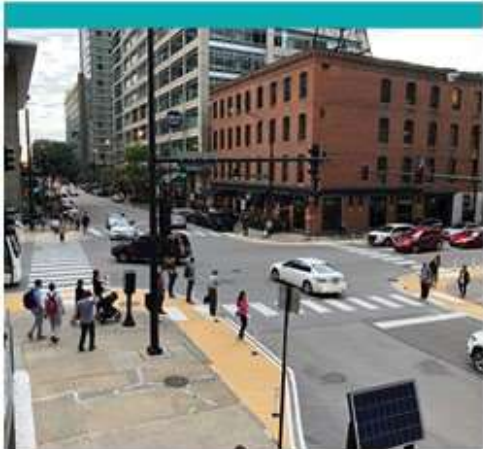

A2 Moving Together Safety Key Strategy: Quick-build program

Examples:

- Curb extension
- Pedestrian refuge island
- Protected bike lane
- Bicycle intersection improvements
- Mini traffic circles
- Diverters
- Hardened centerlines
- Slow-turn wedges

Fifth Avenue at Beakes Avenue

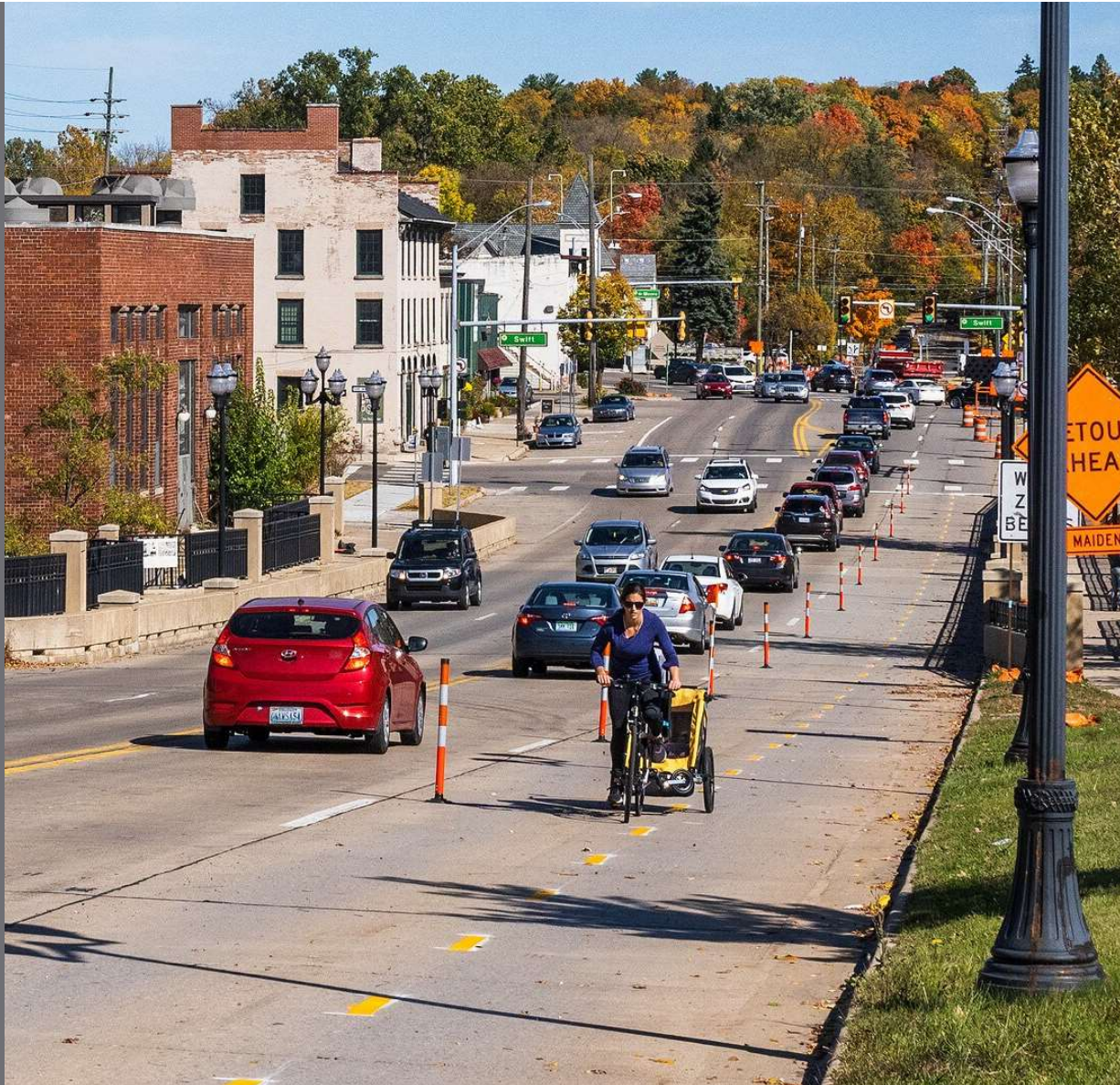
Pavement markings
